- Matthew 24:11-14 And many false prophets shall rise, and shall deceive many. And because iniquity shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold. But he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved. And this gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come.
- Multiple chapters in this book, use the preponderance of evidence standard for understanding God's word. The New Testament is the compiled transcripts of eight witnesses that either walked with Jesus, were brothers of or recruited by him. These witnesses state to use two or three witnesses to establish the truth in God's word. God's word is presented in the contract given in the New Testament for the Jew and Gentile. - instruction. Moses did not listen to the witnesses. Moses did not listen to God. God did not allow Moses to take the Hebrews into the promised land. Only Joshua and Caleb made it to the promised land.
- Until Jesus came, the Hebrews were led by prophets and then kings as the Hebrews wanted to be like the other kingdoms of this earth. Isaiah a prophet, spoke of the impending doom of the Hebrews and the birth of the King of the Jews.
- Isaiah 3:8,10 For Jerusalem is ruined, and Judah is fallen: because their tongue and their doings are against the Lord, to provoke the eyes of his glory. Say ye to the righteous, that it shall be well with him: for they shall eat the fruit of their doings.
- Isaiah 9:6 For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace.
- God sent Jesus to bring peace to this world with a simple message.

  Love God and Love neighbor. A message of Love. He tells Peter that you must be a servant and be willing to wash the feet of the lost. You must be a servant to be a bridesmaid for Jesus Christ. You must be ready for his coming. You must receive him as a little child and give up your old self to serve him. The rich man was not willing to give half of what he owned to the poor and follow Jesus. God's message was clear to his disciples, "Take up you cross and follow me." Jesus spoke on using your talents. To use your talents and take up your cross and serve him. Endure until the end serving him and he will judge you on your righteousness and ability to be God-like.
- That is just too complex for the intelligent and ignorant man, trying to deceive God. A sequence verses selected by man with a man-made promise of everlasting life and your salvation can be

secured by serving yourself, say you believe in God and ask him for everlasting life and never lose it, proved to God that man just can't understand instructions. Many times God told you in the Old Testament, that out of the mouth of two three witnesses, you shall know the truth. In the New Testament, at least six times you are told that out of the mouth of two three witnesses, you shall know the truth. God knew that Paul's gospels would be plucked like candy for false doctrine. He told Paul to instruct his followers, four times, that out of the mouth of two three witnesses, you shall know the truth.

After spending my life working in the physical, legal and solving in the spiritual, God told me to look for the Truth out of the mouth of two or three of the eight New Testament witnesses. My goal was to prove the bible real and the truth in the doctrine of God's Word to the men of the jail. Their life of being deceived by the devil is going to stop.

It is apparent that when Jesus, hanging on the cross, said "Father forgive them for they know not what they do," he was referring to mankind. Before he gave up the ghost, after receiving vinegar, he said, "It is finished." James, a man of few words and the brother of Jesus, spoke his gospel in clarity. With all of society living for self and the lust of flesh, James states: "Then when lust has conceived, it bringeth forth sin: and sin, when it is finished, bringeth for death."

When the devil gave man the ability to separate God's word into numbered verses, the perversion of God's word began in the 16th century. The arrogance of man and his ability to produce word salad like false doctrine of God's word, sealed the deal with the devil. During one of my last church witnesses, the pastor taught on honoring God at church with singing, baptism by water and salvation by being saved. Being saved is just about you! - God sent me on my ministry starting with a text message from God, "Ecclesiastes." I was a lover of God and neighbor, but weak on bible knowledge at the age of fifty-nine. I was handed God's jail ministry with a text message from God to a man in distress of "Romans 8:28" on 9/6/21. From there God wrote, these books in this order, Jesus is Coming, Glory Bound, Put God First, Power of God, Out of Darkness, New Beginning, A Bride of Christ, The Ark and the Blood, and now, Church Of Nineveh. These are his books. I had no power on my own to write his books.
- The complete gospel of Jesus Christ for each of God's eight witnesses is contained in Chapter 16 of "A Bride of Christ." The bible number for 16 is Love. Man has been deceived by word salad preaching pastors. Each of these gospels has the same simple message from God. A gospel of believing in Jesus Christ, accepting his shed blood for the forgiveness of your sins, become dead to sin, walking as children of light, following after righteousness, bringing forth fruit unto God unto eternal life.
- God launched his church with a dream on Ecclesiastes 4:12-15. God told me that my witness to the man-made churches was finished

Jonah 1:2-4 - Arise, go to Nineveh, that great city, and cry against it; for their wickedness is come up before me But Jonah rose up to flee unto Tarshish from the presence of the Lord, and went down to Joppa; and he found a ship going to Tarshish: so he paid the fare thereof, and went down into it, to go with them unto Tarshish from the presence of the Lord. But the Lord sent out a great wind into the sea, and there was a mighty tempest in the sea, so that the ship was like to be broken.

God knew that Jonah's faith was weak, so he decided to give Jonah strength. God used a large fish to swallow Jonah and Jonah stayed in his belly three days. Teachers will say that Jonah's time in the belly of the fish is symbolic of the three days that Jesus spent in the earth. I disagree. Jesus did not turn away from the Father and ignore what his Father wanted him to do. He told the criminal on the cross, "Today you will be with me in paradise." The three days for Jonah in the belly of the fish was to correct for Jonah's path. Jonah was now a subject matter expert and hero. God will build you up and give you the power to perform the job he has for you.

Jonah 1:1-5,15,17 - Now the word of the Lord came unto Jonah the son of Amittai, saying, Arise, go to Nineveh, that great city, and cry against it; for their wickedness is come up before me. But Jonah rose up to flee unto Tarshish from the presence of the Lord, and went down to Joppa; and he found a ship going to Tarshish: so he paid the fare thereof, and went down into it, to go with them unto Tarshish from the presence of the Lord. But the Lord sent out a great wind into the sea, and there was a mighty tempest in the sea, so that the ship was like to be broken. Then the mariners were afraid, and cried every man unto his god, and cast forth the wares that were in the ship into the sea, to lighten it of them. But Jonah was gone down into the sides of the ship; and he lay, and was fast asleep. So they took up Jonah, and cast him forth into the sea; and the sea ceased from her raging. Now the Lord had prepared a great fish to swallow up Jonah. And Jonah was in the belly of the fish three days and three nights.

Recognizing the predicament that Jonah was in, he prayed unto the Lord thy God, to take him out of this fish. For the lost, this fish with you in the belly is representative of you lost in your love of self, greed and addiction. When you decide that you want out, pray to God and tell him that you want out! God spit Jonah out of the mouth of the fish. God will give you the power to escape your greed and addiction and life of sin. Being spit out of the fish's mouth, it is time you decide to follow God's commandments, turn from sin, love God and love his children and follow him. God will direct your paths.

Jonah 2:1-2,9-10 - Then Jonah prayed unto the Lord his God out of the fish's belly, And said, I cried by reason of mine affliction unto the Lord, and he heard me; out of the belly of hell cried I, and thou heardest my voice. But I will sacrifice unto thee with the voice of thanksgiving; I will pay that that I have vowed.

- Salvation is of the Lord. And the Lord spake unto the fish, and it vomited out Jonah upon the dry land.
- God picked Jonah in the womb and God's plan for Jonah didn't change. Jonah stood up on the beach and did as God directed! He headed to Nineveh and told them of the impending doom that God had planned for their wicked city! Nineveh agreed and gave glory to God with a fast. They repented and turned from their evil ways and God was pleased. He was no longer going to wipe out the city.
- Jonah 3:1-5,9-10 And the word of the Lord came unto Jonah the second time, saying, Arise, go unto Nineveh, that great city, and preach unto it the preaching that I bid thee. So Jonah arose, and went unto Nineveh, according to the word of the Lord. Now Nineveh was an exceeding great city of three days' journey. And Jonah began to enter into the city a day's journey, and he cried, and said, Yet forty days, and Nineveh shall be overthrown. So the people of Nineveh believed God, and proclaimed a fast, and put on sackcloth, from the greatest of them even to the least of them. Who can tell if God will turn and repent, and turn away from his fierce anger, that we perish not? And God saw their works, that they turned from their evil way; and God repented of the evil, that he had said that he would do unto them; and he did it not.
- The outcome of you serving the Lord is in God's plan. It will not always be what you want. Jonah was no longer going to witness the destruction of Nineveh and he was angry. He was ready to witness the destruction of Nineveh, but their corrective action and worship of God by the Nineveh people, pleased God.
- Jonah 4:1-3,5-8,11 But it displeased Jonah exceedingly, and he was very angry. And he prayed unto the Lord, and said, I pray

thee, O Lord, was not this my saying, when I was yet in my country? Therefore I fled before unto Tarshish: for I knew that thou art a gracious God, and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness, and repentest thee of the evil. Therefore now. O Lord, take, I beseech thee, my life from me; for it is better for me to die than to live. So Jonah went out of the city, and sat on the east side of the city, and there made him a booth, and sat under it in the shadow, till he might see what would become of the city. And the Lord God prepared a gourd, and made it to come up over Jonah, that it might be a shadow over his head, to deliver him from his grief. So Jonah was exceeding glad of the gourd. But God prepared a worm when the morning rose the next day, and it smote the gourd that it withered. And it came to pass, when the sun did arise, that God prepared a vehement east wind: and the sun beat upon the head of Jonah, that he fainted, and wished in himself to die, and said, It is better for me to die than to live. And should not I spare Nineveh, that great city, wherein are more than sixscore thousand persons that cannot discern between their right hand and their left hand; and also much cattle?

Why the Nineveh eclipse over North America? North America has turned from the things of God to greed? The greed of money and the greed of self. Killing to satisfy self is to be justified. In 2020, the US National debt was 26 trillion dollars. Four short years later and the US National debt has almost doubled to 35 trillion dollars, with no end in sight. There is no end in sight for the people that want "free" money and to serve self, all for the sake of greed. The US dollar is being handed out freely to those that partake in the genocide of babies. Mostly men wrote the pages of bible. This does not make men any more important than women. Women also wrote history and recorded pages in the bible. I had not planned to go to that solar eclipse, but God had that planned. I just didn't realize that God was giving me a final exam. I will approach this publication from the viewpoint that the bible is real and it is true in all matters of human relationships with life on this planet earth.

When humans came on the scene, it was apparent that they had to have somewhere to live and things to eat. When, how or what time it took to reach the level of humanity that we are at today doesn't matter. All that matters, is that we are here and now. - God made man the most intelligent of all creatures on earth. Man would be able to come up with solutions and cures as diseases develop. Man needed to understand their relationship with their surroundings for survival. For example, England had to figure out that bacteria from sewage leaking into their fresh water supply caused sickness and death. This leakage had almost wiped out the population of the city of London. Every good thing developed by humans was always the result of adversity, disease and sickness. The use of human intelligence, ingenuity and God's will could be used to solve the problems meeting the needs of humanity.
- That same intelligence can now be used for greed, death and destructions. Nuclear power is a wonderful power source.

#### Chapter 4: Saved by Water

- Through Noah's Ark, God saved eight souls from death and offered a new beginning for mankind. Their families knew that to survive and be saved from death, they must love the things of God.
- 1 Peter 3:20 Which sometime were disobedient, when once the longsuffering of God waited in the days of Noah, while the ark was a preparing, wherein few, that is, eight souls were saved by water.
- God said that he would no longer destroy man by water. The rainbow he will send as a token of the covenant between God and the earth.
- Genesis 9:8-9,11-13 And God spake unto Noah, and to his sons with him, saying, And I, behold, I establish my covenant with you, and with your seed after you; And I will establish my covenant with you; neither shall all flesh be cut off any more by the waters of a flood; neither shall there any more be a flood to destroy the earth. And God said, This is the token of the covenant which I make between me and you and every living creature that is with you, for perpetual generations: I do set my bow in the cloud, and it shall be for a token of a covenant between me and the earth.
- The sons of Noah and their wives went different ways. They knew the power of God and that God expected them to love the things of the earth. Many of these offspring continued to live in peace. The American Indians loved and took care of the things of God. The Incas of Mexico loved each other and took care of the things of God.
- God needed to give Moses and the Hebrews a handbook to use to prevent greed from ruling their lives to one of living in peace

- and love. God paved the way for leading the Hebrews from Egypt, for he heard their cries.
- Exodus 3:7-8 And the Lord said, I have surely seen the affliction of my people which are in Egypt, and have heard their cry by reason of their taskmasters; for I know their sorrows; And I am come down to deliver them out of the hand of the Egyptians, and to bring them up out of that land unto a good land and a large, unto a land flowing with milk and honey; unto the place of the Canaanites, and the Hittites, and the Amorites, and the Perizzites, and the Hivites, and the Jebusites.
- Recognizing the need of the greedy to worship idols and hate, God sent the ten commandments to Moses. To hold these commandments and to serve as a witness, God then gave them the Ark of Covenant.
- Exodus 25:10,11, 16-18,21,22 And they shall make an ark of shittim wood: two cubits and a half shall be the length thereof, and a cubit and a half the breadth thereof, and a cubit and a half the height thereof. And thou shalt overlay it with pure gold, within and without shalt thou overlay it, and shalt make upon it a crown of gold round about. And thou shalt put into the ark the testimony which I shall give thee. And thou shalt make a mercy seat of pure gold: two cubits and a half shall be the length thereof, and a cubit and a half the breadth thereof. And thou shalt make two cherubims of gold, of beaten work shalt thou make them, in the two ends of the mercy seat. And thou shalt put the mercy seat above upon the ark; and in the ark thou shalt put the testimony that I shall give thee. And there I will meet with thee, and I will commune with thee from above the mercy seat, from between the two cherubims which are upon the ark of the testimony, of all things which I will give thee in commandment unto the children of Israel.

- Upon this ark, the children of Israel would offer blood sacrifices for a peace offering to God for the forgiveness of sins.
- 1 Chronicles 16:1 So they brought the ark of God, and set it in the midst of the tent that David had pitched for it: and they offered burnt sacrifices and peace offerings before God.
- What started as a monument of the covenant between the Hebrews and God, ended up being a tool to hold the Israels captive. No longer being able to serve God, but a continual reminder of their sins that offended God and hours upon hours of making blood sacrifices to God. No longer serving God, but a life of sin followed by serving ceremony of the sin offering to God. The love of God and the love of neighbor was not in this story.
- No longer serving God or accepting his power, the Ark was hidden during the time of Jeremiah.
- Jeremiah 3:16 And it shall come to pass, when ye be multiplied and increased in the land, in those days, saith the Lord, they shall say no more, The ark of the covenant of the Lord: neither shall it come to mind: neither shall they remember it; neither shall they visit it; neither shall that be done any more.
- God sent his son Jesus, to be a propitiation for your sins. One final act of God's mercy, so that your sins could be forgiven.
- 1 John 4:10 Herein is love, not that we loved God, but that he loved us, and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins.
- The death and shed blood of Jesus Christ was orchestrated by God, so that the shed blood of the Almighty would be a sin offering. The rock was split at the base of the cross to above the mercy seat. Jesus's blood was offered as a sacrifice for you sins upon the mercy seat of the Ark of the Covenant.

- Matthew 27:50-51 Jesus, when he had cried again with a loud voice, yielded up the ghost. And, behold, the veil of the temple was rent in twain from the top to the bottom; and the earth did quake, and the rocks rent.
- John 19:34-36 But one of the soldiers with a spear pierced his side, and forthwith came there out blood and water. And he that saw it bare record, and his record is true: and he knoweth that he saith true, that ye might believe. For these things were done, that the scripture should be fulfilled, A bone of him shall not be broken.

A death on the cross for the King of the Jews. The Jews already loved God. They didn't feel the need to worship Jesus. The Gentiles loved him. 1940 years later, a Gentile by the name of Ron Wyatt, told God to use him for his honor and glory and to prove the bible real. God directed Ron to find, Noah's Ark, the Red Sea crossing, Mt Sinai, Sodom and Gomorrah and the Ark of the Covenant. God needed Ron to discover the Ark of the Covenant. He gave Ron the experience he needed to have the blood of Jesus analyzed by experts. Ron's professional training was in anesthesiology and he knew blood. While Ron was walking outside the walls of Jerusalem, God directed Ron where to dig and to find the Ark of the Covenant. In an area filled with loose rock, like as a dump, Ron found the original site of where Jesus was crucified. At the base of the cross, the rock was rent or cracked as described in the bible at the time of the death of Jesus. On January 1982, in a cave immediately below this crack, Ron had found the Ark of the Covenant covered in dried blood. He scrapped the blood and filled a 35mm film cannister. The blood was reconstituted in saline at body temperature by stirring for 72 hours and it became alive with white blood cells. This is not normal as white blood cells of dried blood are dead and never come back to life. Jesus's blood came back to life. The white blood cells contained only

24 chromosomes and not the normal 46. 23 chromosomes were from Mary and only 1 (a single Y chromosome) from the Holy Ghost. The other 22 chromosomes, normally from a male, were not there. With physical characteristics, as of Mary, he was truly made by God. Jesus was no ordinary man. Only half Jew, like as a Samarian.

The Jewish leaders told Ron Wyatt that the Ark of the Covenant would be unveiled when the temple was finished.

The Gentiles loved Jesus. Would you recognize Jesus if you saw him 2000 years ago? Will you believe in Jesus and that by his blood your sins have been forgiven? Will you fall in love with God and follow him? Don't judge anyone. Love the things of this earth and serve the Lord. God will be waiting for you on judgement day.

Revelation 20:13 - And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works.

## Chapter 5: Two Witnesses – Preponderance of Evidence.

- God made it clear that out of the mouth of two or three witnesses, you will hear the truth. When there is in decision on a principle, the greater number of witnesses, solidifies the truth.
- The Bible is a contract between you and God. The Old Testament is a series of prophets, kings and lovers of God that wrote books and prophecies. Lesson after lesson is about God sending forth two witnesses so as to obtain the truth. The New Testament is the compiled transcripts of eight witnesses that walked with, were brothers of or recruited by Jesus. Three New Testament witnesses made it clear in at least seven verses that you use two or three witnesses to establish God's word. God knew that Paul's teachings would get plucked and abused. Paul said four times that you must establish the truth by two or three witnesses. This is not a new principle. It is mandatory.

#### Old Testament:

- Deuteronomy 17:6 At the mouth of two witnesses, or three witnesses, shall he that is worthy of death be put to death; but at the mouth of one witness he shall not be put to death.
- Deuteronomy 19:15 One witness shall not rise up against a man for any iniquity, or for any sin, in any sin that he sinneth: at the mouth of two witnesses, or at the mouth of three witnesses, shall the matter be established.
- 1 Kings 21:10 And set two men, sons of Belial, before him, to bear witness against him, saying, Thou didst blaspheme God and the king. And then carry him out, and stone him, that he may die.
- 1 Kings 21:13 And there came in two men, children of Belial, and sat before him: and the men of Belial witnessed against him, even against Naboth, in the presence of the people, saying,

- Naboth did blaspheme God and the king. Then they carried him forth out of the city, and stoned him with stones, that he died.
- God used two angels throughout the bible to present his messages.

  Two angels came to tell Lot to take his family and leave the city of sin.
- Genesis 19:1,15 And there came two angels to Sodom at even; and Lot sat in the gate of Sodom: and Lot seeing them rose up to meet them; and he bowed himself with his face toward the ground; And when the morning arose, then the angels hastened Lot, saying, Arise, take thy wife, and thy two daughters, which are here; lest thou be consumed in the iniquity of the city.

God used two witnesses to develop the house of Israel.

- Ruth 4:11 And all the people that were in the gate, and the elders, said, We are witnesses. The Lord make the woman that is come into thine house like Rachel and like Leah, which two did build the house of Israel: and do thou worthily in Ephratah, and be famous in Bethlehem:
- Joshua was one of the two witnesses sent to Moses, that refused to put his trust in them. Joshua knew the importance of two witnesses. The house of Rahab was spared by Joshua, as a result of these two witnesses.
- Joshua 2:1-4,9-10,14-15 And Joshua the son of Nun sent out of Shittim two men to spy secretly, saying, Go view the land, even Jericho. And they went, and came into an harlot's house, named Rahab, and lodged there. And it was told the king of Jericho, saying, Behold, there came men in hither to night of the children of Israel to search out the country. And the king of Jericho sent unto Rahab, saying, Bring forth the men that

are come to thee, which are entered into thine house: for they be come to search out all the country. And the woman took the two men, and hid them, and said thus, There came men unto me, but I wist not whence they were: And she said unto the men, I know that the Lord hath given you the land, and that your terror is fallen upon us, and that all the inhabitants of the land faint because of you. For we have heard how the Lord dried up the water of the Red sea for you, when ye came out of Egypt: and what ve did unto the two kings of the Amorites. that were on the other side Jordan, Sihon and Og, whom ye utterly destroyed. And the men answered her. Our life for yours, if ye utter not this our business. And it shall be, when the Lord hath given us the land, that we will deal kindly and truly with thee. Then she let them down by a cord through the window: for her house was upon the town wall, and she dwelt upon the wall.

#### New Testament:

- God made it clear that out of the mouth of two or three witnesses, you will hear the truth. What Jesus said is of his Father. His word is the testimony of two people.
- Matthew 18:16 <u>But if he will not hear thee, then take with thee</u> one or two more, that in the mouth of two or three witnesses every word may be established.
- John 8:17-18 <u>It is also written in your law, that the testimony of</u>
  two men is true. I am one that bear witness of myself, and the
  <u>Father that sent me beareth witness of me.</u>
- 2 Corinthians 13:1 This is the third time I am coming to you. In the mouth of two or three witnesses shall every word be established.

- Hebrews 6:18 That by two immutable things, in which it was impossible for God to lie, we might have a strong consolation, who have fled for refuge to lay hold upon the hope set before us:
- Hebrews 10:28 He that despised Moses' law died without mercy under two or three witnesses:
- 1 Timothy 5:19 Against an elder receive not an accusation, but before two or three witnesses.
- The last reference to the use of two witnesses in the bible, is in Revelation.
- Revelation 11:3 And I will give power unto my two witnesses, and they shall prophesy a thousand two hundred and threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.
- God made it a practice to send two witnesses in the New Testament.
- God sent two angels at the tomb, to witness to Mary Magdalene.
- John 20:11-12 But Mary stood without at the sepulchre weeping: and as she wept, she stooped down, and looked into the sepulchre, And seeth two angels in white sitting, the one at the head, and the other at the feet, where the body of Jesus had lain.
- God sent his disciples out two by two.
- Mark 6:7,12 And he called unto him the twelve, and began to send them forth by two and two; and gave them power over unclean spirits; And they went out, and preached that men should repent.
- Additional verses of two witnesses throughout the New Testament.

- 2 Timothy 2:2 And the things that thou hast heard of me among many witnesses, the same commit thou to faithful men, who shall be able to teach others also.
- James 2:25 Likewise also was not Rahab the harlot justified by works, when she had received the messengers, and had sent them out another way?
- You must then use the testimony of two or three witnesses in order to understand the truth and not by special interpretation. This is sound doctrine.
- 2 Timothy 3:16 All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness:
- 2 Timothy 4:3-5 For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears; And they shall turn away their ears from the truth, and shall be turned unto fables. But watch thou in all things, endure afflictions, do the work of an evangelist, make full proof of thy ministry.
- 2 Peter 1:19-21 We have also a more sure word of prophecy; whereunto ye do well that ye take heed, as unto a light that shineth in a dark place, until the day dawn, and the day star arise in your hearts: Knowing this first, that no prophecy of the scripture is of any private interpretation. For the prophecy came not in old time by the will of man: but holy men of God spake as they were moved by the Holy Ghost.
- Using the above example, let's look at the testimony of just one more witness, besides Paul.
- 1 Peter 3:3-4 Whose adorning let it not be that outward adorning of plaiting the hair, and of wearing of gold, or of putting on of apparel; But let it be the hidden man of the heart, in that

- which is not corruptible, even the ornament of a meek and quiet spirit, which is in the sight of God of great price.
- Peter, as the #1 draft pick that walked with Jesus, got it. Just one more witness and you get the truth in God's word. Outward appearance means nothing. All that matters is what is in your heart. Go live your life for the glory of God and with a pure heart you shall see God!
- Matthew 25:46 And these shall go away into everlasting punishment: but the righteous into life eternal.
- John 12:46 <u>I am come a light into the world, that whosoever</u> believeth on me should not abide in darkness.
- Matthew 5:8 Blessed are the pure in heart: for they shall see God.
- Throughout my ministry, God has sent me many witnesses, one right after the other, to convey his doctrine to me in truth. I listened and believed.
- God could not have been more clear in the bible that you must understand his doctrine as conveyed by the witnesses.
- The Inca Indians as descendants from Noah were living their life for the glory of God, as instructed by God when the descendants migrated North East from Noah's Ark.
- The Spanish conquistadors were driven by greed and failed to adhere to God's words. To love God, love neighbor and avoid the love of the false god of filthy lucre.
- God's word and doctrine developed for the Church Of Nineveh is from the two or three witnesses of God's word the bible. A doctrine of love for all things of God.
- To God be the glory in all you do, Amen.

# Chapter 6: Redemption

- We celebrated the resurrection of Christ on 3/31,24. The power of the Trinity was fulfilled and when you put your trust in God and you become his offspring. Yes, the bible number for offspring is 31! God is offering you salvation through the blood of Jesus. Redemption is offered not by knowing God, but trusting him. By walking in the light as Jesus walked in the light. When you walk in the light, you are a new creature, you're a new person with your sins washed away. No longer felling guilty, but part of God's kingdom of Love.
- 1 John 1:7 <u>But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have</u> <u>fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his</u> Son cleanseth us from all sin.
- Matthew 5:16 <u>Let your light so shine before men, that they may</u> see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.
- When you trust Jesus and eat of his flesh, you understand what he wants you to do. The flesh is the Word of God.
- John 1:1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.
- God instructions starts with God (Genesis) and ends with God (Revelation). God wants you to only listen to him.
- Genesis 1:1 In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.
- Revelation 22:13 <u>I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the</u> end, the first and the last.
- God has told you to understand the truth in his word out of the mouth of two witnesses.

- Deuteronomy 19:15 One witness shall not rise up against a man for any iniquity, or for any sin, in any sin that he sinneth: at the mouth of two witnesses, or at the mouth of three witnesses, shall the matter be established.
- Both Joshua the son of Nun and Caleb the son of Jephunneh were spies that had been sent by Moses to the land of Canaan. Both returned and told Moses, Aaron and the assembly of the Israelites not to fear the giants that dwelled in Canaan
- Numbers 14:9 Only rebel not ye against the Lord, neither fear ye the people of the land; for they are bread for us: their defence is departed from them, and the Lord is with us: fear them not.
- Moses feared the giants and he did not enter the promise land. This is not the only time Moses defied the Lord. Earlier Moses had married an Ethiopian woman against God's will. Two witnesses spoke against it.
- Numbers 12:1 And Miriam and Aaron spake against Moses because of the Ethiopian woman whom he had married: for he had married an Ethiopian woman.

The third time that Moses defied the Lord, it offended God.

Numbers 20:8-13 - Take the rod, and gather thou the assembly together, thou, and Aaron thy brother, and speak ye unto the rock before their eyes; and it shall give forth his water, and thou shalt bring forth to them water out of the rock: so thou shalt give the congregation and their beasts drink. And Moses took the rod from before the Lord, as he commanded him. And Moses and Aaron gathered the congregation together before the rock, and he said unto them, Hear now, ye rebels; must we fetch you water out of this rock? And Moses lifted up his hand, and with his rod he smote the rock twice: and the water came out abundantly, and the congregation drank, and

their beasts also. And the Lord spake unto Moses and Aaron, Because ye believed me not, to sanctify me in the eyes of the children of Israel, therefore ye shall not bring this congregation into the land which I have given them. This is the water of Meribah; because the children of Israel strove with the Lord, and he was sanctified in them.

- Later, Joshua sent two witnesses to spy on Jericho. Rahab believed that their God would destroy the city. She asked to be saved from death if she helped the spies escape. Joshua believed the two witnesses and God spared Rahab and her family.
- Joshua 2:1 And Joshua the son of Nun sent out of Shittim two men to spy secretly, saying, Go view the land, even Jericho. And they went, and came into a harlot's house, named Rahab, and lodged there.
- Joshua 6:25 And Joshua saved Rahab the harlot alive, and her father's household, and all that she had; and she dwelleth in Israel even unto this day; because she hid the messengers, which Joshua sent to spy out Jericho.
- God magnified Joshua because he listened to the Lord
- Joshua 3:7 And the Lord said unto Joshua, This day will I begin to magnify thee in the sight of all Israel, that they may know that, as I was with Moses, so I will be with thee.
- With the shed blood of Jesus, God offers you redemption and the gift of everlasting life! This gift is available when you listen to the word of God. When you put your trust in him, God will make unto you; wisdom, righteousness, sanctification and redemption.
- 1 Corinthians 1:30 But of him are ye in Christ Jesus, who of God is made unto us wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption:

- You know from his word, how the will of God is to work in your life. God has a plan for you. Redemption is about putting your trust in God, repenting of your sins and to go live a righteous life to the praise and glory of your Creator.
- Ephesians 1:4-5,7-8,12-13 According as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love: Having predestinated us unto the adoption of children by Jesus Christ to himself, according to the good pleasure of his will, In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace; Wherein he hath abounded toward us in all wisdom and prudence; That we should be to the praise of his glory, who first trusted in Christ. In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that Holy Spirit of promise,

Your salvation is based on doing the will of God.

- Hebrews 9:15 And for this cause he is the mediator of the new testament, that by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions that were under the first testament, they which are called might receive the promise of eternal inheritance.
- Matthew 7:21 <u>Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall</u> enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.

To God be the glory in all you do, Amen.

# Chapter 7: Pure Love

God's message in the New Testament is just one of love.

Look around you and the people you are in contact with. You know which ones love from the heart. You know which ones you could ask for help and they would show up. You also know which ones are all about money. You also know which one can blow up pretty fast when conflict arises. Now, think of the Creator. The Creator knows and judges one from the heart. The love from the heart is what matters. He knew the sons of Noah. He knew which son loved the things of God. He knew which one was trouble. He knew which one loved filthy lucre. They each worked on the boat with Noah and they all had different talents. They all knew the evil that existed when God directed the boat to be built and then flooded the earth. They knew death and destruction. They floated for forty days and took care of the things of God. He sent them off two by two from the ark and each son both feared God and they each knew the power of God. Could they pass the fear of God and the love of the God's creation down through the generations? Would their offspring worship only things of God and to hold all things sacred, loving each other and loving God? Could they dwell amongst others in peace?

In the thirty-eight generations between Noah and Jesus, tens of millions of people had migrated to and settled the continents of Eurasia and Africa. Japeth was believed to head North and North East. Shem headed East and South East and Ham headed South and South West. The descendants of Noah continued to migrate across the Bering Strait and then down the west coast of the Americas into South America. Some were righteous and lived life as directed to Noah by God. They had love for each other and the earth. They coexisted on this earth

in love and peace. God was not worried about them as they were going to live their life for the glory of God.

God was not worried about the Inca Indians in the Americas. He was worried for the Inca Indians. The Incas were able to construct "one of the greatest imperial states in human history" without the use of the wheel, draft animals, knowledge of iron or steel, or even a system of writing. The Inca Empire functioned largely without money and without markets. Instead, exchange of goods and services was based on reciprocity between individuals and among individuals, groups, and Inca rulers. They lived their life to the glory of God. That is until another group of Noah's descendants, that had moved into Western Europe, arrived in the 1500's. The Spanish began the conquest of the Inca Empire in 1532 and by 1572, the last Inca state was fully conquered. Forty years it took, to conquer the Inca state. The Incas held no value in gold, because they did not need of it for trade, but the Spaniards killed for it. This is exactly what God was worried about. Forty years to defeat and kill a God-fearing, peace-loving people, all for the sake of gold. The lost Spanish descendants, out of ignorance in understanding God's word and greed, would destroy people and then the world. The Inca civilization was living a life of love in friendly coexistence as directed by God to the ancestors sent from Noah's Ark. Greed and the love of money had wiped out the world of the Incas.

The Spanish then brought their missionaries to teach the Incas about their God. The Incas already knew about God and the God of love as their God was the God of love. The greed of the king for power and wealth had overwhelmed the spirit that directs one to care for and love man and the things of God. In their ignorance, the Spanish did not recognize the Inca's as children of God, descendants from Noah's Ark.

- These conquistadors were not taught God's doctrine and the truth out of the mouth of two or three witnesses. God knew that the unrighteous people that worshipped the god of greed were going to need someone to model their life after. God sent Jesus through the Hebrews, so the world being led by greed, through him might be saved. Jesus had to be human, so that man could relate to his teachings. He had to be human, to make sure the unrighteous would know that he would be judging them.
- John 3:17 For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved.
- Jesus warned of the greed of man and the errors of living for filthy lucre. Jesus gave you but two commandments: Love God and love your neighbor. John tells you that the love of others shows your love of God! If you can't love your neighbor, how can you love God. There is no greater love, than the love of others.
- 1 John 4:19-21 We love him, because he first loved us. If a man say, I love God, and hateth his brother, he is a liar: for he that loveth not his brother whom he hath seen, how can he love God whom he hath not seen? And this commandment have we from him, That he who loveth God love his brother also.
- John 15:9-14 As the Father hath loved me, so have I loved you:

  continue ye in my love. If ye keep my commandments, ye shall
  abide in my love; even as I have kept my Father's
  commandments, and abide in his love. These things have I
  spoken unto you, that my joy might remain in you, and that
  your joy might be full. This is my commandment, That ye love
  one another, as I have loved you. Greater love hath no man
  than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends. Ye are
  my friends, if ye do whatsoever I command you.
- The greatest single evidence of being converted from self-love to the love of others is Mother Teresa. After Mother Teresa

founded her religious congregation, it grew to have over 4,500 nuns and was active in 133 countries as of 2012. The congregation manages homes for people who are dying of HIV/AIDS, leprosy, and tuberculosis. The congregation also runs soup kitchens, dispensaries, mobile clinics, children's and family counselling programs, as well as orphanages and schools. Members take vows of chastity, poverty, and obedience and also profess a fourth vow: to give "wholehearted free service to the poorest of the poor."

Here is what she said to President Clinton about abortion.

"I feel that the greatest destroyer of peace today is abortion, because it is a war against the child, a direct killing of the innocent child, murder by the mother herself. And if we accept that a mother can kill even her own child, how can we tell other people not to kill one another? How do we persuade a woman not to have an abortion? As always, we must persuade her with love and we remind ourselves that love means to be willing to give until it hurts. Jesus laid down even his life out of love for us. So, the mother who is thinking of abortion, should be helped to love, that is, to give until it hurts her plans, or her free time, to respect the life of her child. The father of that child, whoever he is, must also give until it hurts.

By abortion, the mother does not learn to love, but kills even her own child to solve her problems. And, by abortion, that father is told that he does not have to take any responsibility at all for the child he has brought into the world. The father is likely to put other women into the same trouble. So, abortion just leads to more abortion. Any country that accepts abortion is not teaching its people to love, but to use any violence to get what they want. This is why the greatest destroyer of love and peace is abortion."

- Pure love is about love for life and all things of God. God gave you a commandment not to kill. There is a reason. If one can destroy the living, then there can be no love for the living. You can't kill and love life. You are double minded and unstable in all your ways.
- James 1:8 A double minded man is unstable in all his ways.
- God's directions are clear. You are not to worship self nor the god of greed. You are put here to be the best you now and serve others. You are to respect your Creator and to respect all things living. You are put here to be a servant to the spiritual lost. You are a servant per the royal law.
- James 2:8 If ye fulfil the royal law according to the scripture, Thou shalt love thy neighbor as thyself, ye do well:
- To be a servant to your Creator per the royal law is to believe that it is your responsibility:
- To develop the talents God has given you to be the best you now.
- To reach, serve and raise the spiritual lost, weak and poor to be the best that they can be.
- To care for the things of this earth and to not judge the righteousness of others.
- To love and serve others.
- To love and serve God.
- A man cannot judge the righteousness of others. A man cannot save you or say you are saved. A man judges from the flesh. A man has no knowledge of a person's heart nor a person's love of the things of God. For when a man judges, he is but a pompous fool. You are not to be a lover of filthy lucre, but willing to share the blessings that God has bestowed upon you.

You are to be good steward of the things and blessings that God has given you. God judges from the heart. You serve a merciful Lord, who rewards those that sow love and peace. Now, go live your life for the glory of God! To love and serve as directed by James. To love and serve as directed by God.

To God be the glory in all you do, Amen

# Chapter 8: Judge Not

It is clear from the New Testament that a man is not capable of judging the righteousness of another. Serving God in righteousness comes from the heart. When it comes to loving the things of God, all hearts are not created the same! Man sees the flesh and judges the flesh. The only unforgiveable sin is blaspheming the Holy Ghost. When Peter said that he would follow Jesus in death, Jesus calmly said that Peter would not only deny him, but that Peter would deny him three times. The apostles looking upon Peter's testimony would have judged Peter's righteousness completely wrong. God sees the heart.

John 13:36-38 - Simon Peter said unto him, Lord, whither goest thou? Jesus answered him, Whither I go, thou canst not follow me now; but thou shalt follow me afterwards. Peter said unto him, Lord, why cannot I follow thee now? I will lay down my life for thy sake. Jesus answered him, Wilt thou lay down thy life for my sake? Verily, verily, I say unto thee, The cock shall not crow, till thou hast denied me thrice.

That is the problem when man judges. A man will automatically look upon sin and judge it relative to other sin. Sins of the flesh are considered by man to more serious than the sin of denying God! When it comes to sin, the question is due you love the things of God and love your neighbor? Do you love from the heart, in a manner that you are willing to share that love. The moment, you judge from appearance, the devil has your heart and the devil will turn you away from the loving the things of God. Your judgement has resulted in the love of God from being shared. You will have denied God. You will deny God because of your judgement. Jesus healed on the sabbath. The Pharisees looked upon him as a sinner, even though they performed circumcision on the sabbath.

- John 7:22-24 Moses therefore gave unto you circumcision; (not because it is of Moses, but of the fathers;) and ye on the sabbath day circumcise a man. If a man on the sabbath day receive circumcision, that the law of Moses should not be broken; are ye angry at me, because I have made a man every whit whole on the sabbath day? Judge not according to the appearance, but judge righteous judgment.
- Even the apostles judged. John called Judas Iscariot a thief. Judas took care of the finances for the apostles and Jesus. That would not have been an easy responsibility. When Judas was offered 30 pieces of silver for pointing out Jesus, to him that was easy money for Jesus's ministry. When Judas saw that Jesus was condemned, he repented.
- Matthew 27:3 Then Judas, which had betrayed him, when he saw that he was condemned, repented himself, and brought again the thirty pieces of silver to the chief priests and elders,
- One Inca Indian had more love in his heart for the things of God than the combined love of everyone of those conquistadors. A man judges in the dark. A man has no ability to judge others. God judges in the light.
- 1 Corinthians 4:5 Therefore judge nothing before the time, until the Lord come, who both will bring to light the hidden things of darkness, and will make manifest the counsels of the hearts: and then shall every man have praise of God.
- Even the Jews knew that they could not judge one to death. And yet, man feels qualified to condemn people to hell by judging the sins of the flesh, every day! When man judges based on sin, he denies God.

- John 18:31 Then said Pilate unto them, Take ye him, and judge him according to your law. The Jews therefore said unto him, It is not lawful for us to put any man to death:
- Paul told the Corinthians that they are unworthy to judge even the smallest matters!
- 1 Corinthians 6:2 Do ye not know that the saints shall judge the world? and if the world shall be judged by you, are ye unworthy to judge the smallest matters?
- Jesus was clear in his teachings. Judge no one! People serve God and the things of God, out of the love of their heart. When you judge, you judge out of jealously. For Martha and Peter, Jesus told them to judge only their service to God using the talents he has given you and do not judge another person's righteousness.
- Luke 10:38-42 Now it came to pass, as they went, that he entered into a certain village: and a certain woman named Martha received him into her house. And she had a sister called Mary, which also sat at Jesus' feet, and heard his word. But Martha was cumbered about much serving, and came to him, and said, Lord, dost thou not care that my sister hath left me to serve alone? bid her therefore that she help me. And Jesus answered and said unto her, Martha, Martha, thou art careful and troubled about many things: But one thing is needful: and Mary hath chosen that good part, which shall not be taken away from her.
- John 21:20-23 Then Peter, turning about, seeth the disciple whom Jesus loved following; which also leaned on his breast at supper, and said, Lord, which is he that betrayeth thee? Peter seeing him saith to Jesus, Lord, and what shall this man do? Jesus saith unto him, If I will that he tarry till I come, what is that to thee? follow thou me. Then went this saying abroad among the brethren, that that disciple should not die: yet Jesus

said not unto him, <u>He shall not die; but, If I will that he tarry till</u> I come, what is that to thee?

Simon, a Pharisee, invited Jesus in for dinner and offered little hospitality. Simon judged in the flesh and downplayed the woman as a sinner that came into the house to wash Jesus's feet with her hair. Jesus knew what was in each of their hearts. The woman loved from the heart and was willing to be a faithful servant. Jesus recognized her faith by her works.

Luke 7:36-50 - And one of the Pharisees desired him that he would eat with him. And he went into the Pharisee's house, and sat down to meat. And, behold, a woman in the city, which was a sinner, when she knew that Jesus sat at meat in the Pharisee's house, brought an alabaster box of ointment, And stood at his feet behind him weeping, and began to wash his feet with tears, and did wipe them with the hairs of her head, and kissed his feet, and anointed them with the ointment. Now when the Pharisee which had bidden him saw it, he spake within himself. saying, This man, if he were a prophet, would have known who and what manner of woman this is that toucheth him: for she is a sinner. And Jesus answering said unto him, Simon, I have somewhat to say unto thee. And he saith, Master, say on. There was a certain creditor which had two debtors: the one owed five hundred pence, and the other fifty. And when they had nothing to pay, he frankly forgave them both. Tell me therefore, which of them will love him most? Simon answered and said, I suppose that he, to whom he forgave most. And he said unto him, Thou hast rightly judged. And he turned to the woman, and said unto Simon, Seest thou this woman? I entered into thine house, thou gavest me no water for my feet: but she hath washed my feet with tears, and wiped them with the hairs of her head. Thou gavest me no kiss: but this woman since the time I came in hath not ceased to kiss my feet. My head with oil thou didst not anoint: but this woman

hath anointed my feet with ointment. Wherefore I say unto thee, Her sins, which are many, are forgiven; for she loved much: but to whom little is forgiven, the same loveth little.

And he said unto her, Thy sins are forgiven. And they that sat at meat with him began to say within themselves, Who is this that forgiveth sins also? And he said to the woman, Thy faith hath saved thee; go in peace.

Both John and Judas Iscariot judged during the act of Mary Magdelene washing Jesus's feet with her hair! Judas said the money for the ointment should have been given to the poor. John called Judas a thief. They judged each other and denied God his glory.

John 12:2-8 - There they made him a supper; and Martha served: but Lazarus was one of them that sat at the table with him. Then took Mary a pound of ointment of spikenard, very costly, and anointed the feet of Jesus, and wiped his feet with her hair: and the house was filled with the odour of the ointment. Then saith one of his disciples, Judas Iscariot, Simon's son, which should betray him, Why was not this ointment sold for three hundred pence, and given to the poor? This he said, not that he cared for the poor; but because he was a thief, and had the bag, and bare what was put therein. Then said Jesus, Let her alone: against the day of my burying hath she kept this. For the poor always ye have with you; but me ye have not always.

God is clear. Use your God given talents to serve the things of God and out of love, do not deny God. A man cannot judge the righteousness of others. A man has no knowledge of a person's heart for the love of the things of God. You are to be good steward of the things and blessings that God has given you. Whether you have five, two or one talent, God wants you to use them to glorify God and his kingdom here on earth.

Matthew 25:14-26 - For the kingdom of heaven is as a man travelling into a far country, who called his own servants, and delivered unto them his goods. And unto one he gave five talents, to another two, and to another one; to every man according to his several ability; and straightway took his journey. Then he that had received the five talents went and traded with the same, and made them other five talents. And likewise he that had received two, he also gained other two. But he that had received one went and digged in the earth, and hid his lord's money. After a long time the lord of those servants cometh, and reckoneth with them. And so he that had received five talents came and brought other five talents, saying, Lord, thou deliveredst unto me five talents: behold, I have gained beside them five talents more. His lord said unto him. Well done, thou good and faithful servant: thou hast been faithful over a few things, I will make thee ruler over many things: enter thou into the joy of thy lord. He also that had received two talents came and said. Lord, thou deliveredst unto me two talents: behold, I have gained two other talents beside them. His lord said unto him. Well done, good and faithful servant: thou hast been faithful over a few things. I will make thee ruler over many things: enter thou into the joy of thy lord. Then he which had received the one talent came and said, Lord, I knew thee that thou art an hard man, reaping where thou hast not sown, and gathering where thou hast not strawed: And I was afraid, and went and hid thy talent in the earth: lo, there thou hast that is thine. His lord answered and said unto him, Thou wicked and slothful servant, thou knewest that I reap where I sowed not, and gather where I have not strawed:

You serve a merciful Lord, who rewards those that sow love and peace. Do not deny God with your judgements.

Matthew 10:33 - <u>But whosoever shall deny me before men, him</u> will I also deny before my Father which is in heaven.

Now, go live your life for the glory of God! To love, serve and use your talents as directed by God.

# Chapter 9: Heart

- Of everything that is in this world and in your life, God is looking for just one thing and only one thing...your heart. Nothing else will matter in this life as far as God is concerned, unless you give him your heart. Unless you take up your cross and follow him. For many this change of heart does not happen immediately. For Matthew, it was immediate. He arose and followed him.
- Matthew 9:9 And as Jesus passed forth from thence, he saw a man, named Matthew, sitting at the receipt of custom: and he saith unto him, Follow me. And he arose, and followed him.
- In your study of the bible, you will run across verses that clarify God's word in your heart. God gave me many verses that "woke" me up and led me out of the dark with an understanding of God's word. Think about these next two parables that Jesus gave us and think about how church leaders would respond to an individual coming to church to seek God's blessing.
- Mark 10:17-22 And when he was gone forth into the way, there came one running, and kneeled to him, and asked him, Good Master, what shall I do that I may inherit eternal life? And Jesus said unto him, Why callest thou me good? there is none good but one, that is, God. Thou knowest the commandments, Do not commit adultery, Do not kill, Do not steal, Do not bear false witness, Defraud not, Honour thy father and mother. And he answered and said unto him, Master, all these have I observed from my youth. Then Jesus beholding him loved him, and said unto him, One thing thou lackest: go thy way, sell whatsoever thou hast, and give to the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and come, take up the cross, and follow me. And he was sad at that saying, and went away grieved: for he had great possessions.

God had a heads up on this guy's heart, for God knew where his love was. He did not want to follow God. On the other hand, Zacchaeus was a rich man. He sought God Word and understood the teachings of Christ. Zacchaeus gave half of what he owned to the poor. If he stole from someone, then Zacchaeus gave back four-fold. Zacchaeus did not ask for the minimum for salvation. He repented of his sins to Jesus and was asking just for forgiveness. Jesus knew the love in Zacchaeus's heart. Zacchaeus wasn't looking for bare minimum from God. He loved God and one another. God rewards repentant sinners.

Luke 19:1,3-10 - And Jesus entered and passed through Jericho. And he sought to see Jesus who he was; and could not for the press, because he was little of stature. And he ran before, and climbed up into a sycamore tree to see him: for he was to pass that way. And when Jesus came to the place, he looked up, and saw him, and said unto him, Zacchaeus, make haste, and come down; for today I must abide at thy house. And he made haste, and came down, and received him joyfully. And when they saw it, they all murmured, saying, That he was gone to be guest with a man that is a sinner. And Zacchaeus stood, and said unto the Lord; Behold, Lord, the half of my goods I give to the poor; and if I have taken any thing from any man by false accusation, I restore him fourfold. And Jesus said unto him, This day is salvation come to this house, forsomuch as he also is a son of Abraham. For the Son of man is come to seek and to save that which was lost.

In both of these examples, God knew the heart of each individual.

He had an advantage over every religious leader. No one but God, knows what resides in the heart of man. Every religious leader will use the traditions of man and religious denominational lessons to apply a salvation standard that won't change the man's heart toward God or one another.

These traditions, be it circumcision, water baptism, etc., will give a false sense of salvation without changing the lost person's attitude toward God or one another. A promise of salvation cannot be made without the man knowing or living the Gospel of Jesus Christ and doing the will of God. The preponderance of evidence standard used over the last several months of lessons gives a clear picture of what God wants from you. God doesn't want perfection. God wants your heart. Man's traditions will not likely change the attitude of the heart. God's doctrine is clear, that out of the mouth of the two witnesses, you don't have to be judged by man and partake in religious traditions to be part of God's kingdom here on earth. God's Church Of Nineveh, accepts you. Do you need to know more? Visit and read the doctrine of two witnesses as identified by the preponderance of evidence (PoE) testimony in the chapters contained in "A Bride of Christ."

For some, it may never happen. The rich man in the following parable was following the ten commandments and he asked Jesus what does it take to have everlasting life. Jesus told him to sell everything and give it to the poor and follow him. For this rich man, this change of heart is not what he wanted. He walked away from Jesus. Jesus didn't tell him to get baptized in water and for that you'll have everlasting life. Jesus didn't tell him to give his ten percent tithe, show up at church on Sunday and for that you'll have everlasting life. Jesus wanted the rich man's heart. As a bride of Christ, Jesus wants your heart.

Matthew 19:21-22 - Jesus said unto him, <u>If thou wilt be perfect, go</u> and sell that thou hast, and give to the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and come and follow me. But when the young man heard that saying, he went away sorrowful: for he had great possessions.

- Matthew noted this need for a change in heart early in his Gospel.
- Matthew 5:8 Blessed are the pure in heart: for they shall see God.
- Later, Matthew notes the need to change or have a converted heart from a lover of self to a lover of God and one another.
- Matthew 18:3 And said, <u>Verily I say unto you, Except ye be</u> <u>converted, and become as little children, ye shall not enter into</u> the kingdom of heaven.
- It is clear from the Gospel of Jesus Christ that this change of heart is mandatory to see God and spend eternity in heaven. The rich man did not want a change of heart. Nothing man, religion or acts of religion can do for you to bring about this change in heart. Man cannot take a couple of verses from the bible, save you and promise you everlasting life. The only thing that can be hoped for is that by hearing God's Word and by seeing a change of heart in others to lovers of God in the past, that you too may experience a change of heart. You hear his voice and you follow him.
- John 10:27 My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me:
- You know that a converted or changed heart loves God and loves one another.
- Mark 12:30-31 And thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength: this is the first commandment. And the second is like, namely this, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.

  There is none other commandment greater than these.
- Your proof of a change of heart, is seen in how you approach life. Simply, you desire to live a righteous life serving God, serving others and spreading God's word. Sin is a thing of the past.

- Those who continue their life of sin, have not been converted nor have they experienced a change of heart. There is no promise of everlasting life for lovers of the devil and sin.
- Galatians 5:19-21 Now the works of the flesh are manifest, which are these; Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness, Idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies, Envyings, murders, drunkenness, revellings, and such like: of the which I tell you before, as I have also told you in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God.
- 1 Corinthians 6:9-10 Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind, Nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners, shall inherit the kingdom of God.
- God is serious about the need to change your heart to loving others. God equates hate to murder.
- 1 John 3:15 Whosoever hateth his brother is a murderer: and ye know that no murderer hath eternal life abiding in him.
- Will you be tempted by the devil and sin? Absolutely. When tempted, tell God you love him and fight off the devil. The love of God is stronger than the love of sin.
- James 1:12 Blessed is the man that endureth temptation: for when he is tried, he shall receive the crown of life, which the Lord hath promised to them that love him.
- A man of God and a bride of Christ follows after the things of God.
- Matthew 25:45-46 Then shall he answer them, saying, <u>Verily I say</u> unto you, Inasmuch as ye did it not to one of the least of these,

- ye did it not to me. And these shall go away into everlasting punishment: but the righteous into life eternal.
- 1 Timothy 6:11 But thou, O man of God, flee these things; and follow after righteousness, godliness, faith, love, patience, meekness.
- All that matters as a bride of Christ is to see him and be with him in the end.
- Hebrews 12:14 Follow peace with all men, and holiness, without which no man shall see the Lord:
- Jude 1:21 Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life.
- Jesus's brothers, James and Jude got it. For as small as their epistles are, they got it. Looking for books to read in the bible? Start with Jude and then James. Search the scriptures and then testify of Jesus. Labor for the things of this world for God. Be converted from "a think so" salvation to "a know so" salvation mentality. The Kingdom of God is not a mystery.
- John 5:39 <u>Search the scriptures; for in them ye think ye have</u> <u>eternal life: and they are they which testify of me.</u>
- Romans Chapter 6 is all about your change of heart from sin.
- Romans 6:22 But now being made free from sin, and become servants to God, ye have your fruit unto holiness, and the end everlasting life.
- John 6:27 <u>- Labour not for the meat which perisheth, but for that meat which endureth unto everlasting life, which the Son of man shall give unto you: for him hath God the Father sealed.</u>
- Mark 4:11-14 And he said unto them, <u>Unto you it is given to know</u> the mystery of the kingdom of God: but unto them that are

without, all these things are done in parables: That seeing they may see, and not perceive; and hearing they may hear, and not understand; lest at any time they should be converted, and their sins should be forgiven them. And he said unto them, Know ye not this parable? and how then will ye know all parables? The sower soweth the word.

Start by sowing the word to your family and then move on. Your family may not like you now. James and Jude did not appreciate Jesus at first. James and Jude loved Jesus in the end.

To God be the glory in all you do, Amen.

#### Chapter 10: Best You Now

- God is clear in his word. Above all else, he wants you to be the Best You Now. You see, before you were formed in the womb, the Lord chose you. Yes, the Creator of all things, chose you in the womb.
- Isaiah 44:24 Thus saith the Lord, thy redeemer, and he that formed thee from the womb, I am the Lord that maketh all things; that stretcheth forth the heavens alone; that spreadeth abroad the earth by myself;
- Jeremiah 1:4-5 Then the word of the Lord came unto me, saying, Before I formed thee in the belly I knew thee; and before thou camest forth out of the womb I sanctified thee, and I ordained thee a prophet unto the nations.
- By God's breath, all things were made.
- Psalm 33:6 By the word of the Lord were the heavens made; and all the host of them by the breath of his mouth.
- Yes, God the Creator of all things chose you before the foundation of the world.
- Ephesians 1:4-7 According as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love: Having predestinated us unto the adoption of children by Jesus Christ to himself, according to the good pleasure of his will, To the praise of the glory of his grace, wherein he hath made us accepted in the beloved. In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace;
- God has created you to walk in his light. Walking in sin, alcohol, addiction and darkness is the makings of the devil to keep you from using the talents that God has given you.

- John 1:3-5, All things were made by him; and without him was not anything made that was made. In him was life; and the life was the light of men. And the light shineth in darkness; and the darkness comprehended it not.
- The devil are fallen angels that left their habitation kept by the power of God, unto everlasting darkness. A darkness that they want you to dwell in. Wandering stars that have no hope.
- Jude 1:6,13 And the angels which kept not their first estate, but left their own habitation, he hath reserved in everlasting chains under darkness unto the judgment of the great day. Raging waves of the sea, foaming out their own shame; wandering stars, to whom is reserved the blackness of darkness forever
- The devil will keep you in the spirit of fear. Driving doubt into your spirit and hindering your ability to use the talents that God has given you. God has given you the power to walk in light, love and of sound mind.
- 2 Timothy 1:7 For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.

God is light and in him is no darkness.

1 John 1:5 - This then is the message which we have heard of him, and declare unto you, that God is light, and in him is no darkness at all.

You are his workmanship, born to do good works.

Ephesians 2:10 - For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them.

- Yes, God commands you to work, to do your best work. Not slothful in business, but serving him, by being the Best You Now.
- Thessalonians 3:10 For even when we were with you, this we commanded you, that if any would not work, neither should he eat.
- Romans 12:11 Not slothful in business; fervent in spirit; serving the Lord;
- The Best You Now, kept by the power of God.
- 1 Corinthians 4:20 For the kingdom of God is not in word, but in power.
- You will need the power of God to wrestle against the devil and darkness.
- Ephesians 6:12-13 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places. Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.
- Put your trust in God and be not afraid.
- Psalm 91:4-6 He shall cover thee with his feathers, and under his wings shalt thou trust: his truth shall be thy shield and buckler. Thou shalt not be afraid for the terror by night; nor for the arrow that flieth by day; Nor for the pestilence that walketh in darkness; nor for the destruction that wasteth at noonday.
- You will need the power of God to open your eyes. Using the power of God, to see all that you can be.
- Acts 26:18 To open their eyes, and to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan unto God, that they may

- receive forgiveness of sins, and inheritance among them which are sanctified by faith that is in me.
- To understand the best gifts that he has given you. To use in a more excellent way.
- 1 Corinthians 12:31 But covet earnestly the best gifts: and yet shew I unto you a more excellent way.
- God has an inheritance waiting for you. Planned for you with skills, yet untapped. Skills that you may not know that you have.

  Skills that will be developed which give glory to God, when first you put your trust in him.
- Ephesians 1:11-12 In whom also we have obtained an inheritance, being predestinated according to the purpose of him who worketh all things after the counsel of his own will: That we should be to the praise of his glory, who first trusted in Christ.
- Pray to God for the power to always walk in the light of your Lord.

  To do as he requests and do not abide in darkness. To give God
  your best. To be the Best You Now!
- To God be the glory in all you do, Amen.

# Chapter 11: Drunkenness - Preponderance of Evidence

Nothing leads to more destruction in relationships, home and careers than drunkenness. God promises Fruits of the Spirit for his followers that abide in his word. You may be in a relationship, living in the sins of the flesh and you can't understand why you don't feel God's blessings. Such is the case with drunkenness. The preponderance of evidence standard will be used to confirm God's position on drunkenness.

#### Case Testimony:

- A man in the flesh will immediately point to these two verses to justify his drunkenness. Jesus drank wine. It is OK!
- Matthew 11:19 The Son of man came eating and drinking, and they say, Behold a man gluttonous, and a winebibber, a friend of publicans and sinners. But wisdom is justified of her children.
- Luke 7:34,38 The Son of man is come eating and drinking; and ye say, Behold a gluttonous man, and a winebibber, a friend of publicans and sinners!
- 2000 years ago, there was not a Jerusalem Water Works. People drank wine to settle their stomach. Drinking a little wine to settle your stomach does not constitute drunkenness. I've traveled to over 25 countries and on occasion had to settle my stomach.
- 1 Timothy 5:23 Drink no longer water, but use a little wine for thy stomach's sake and thine often infirmities.
- When you love God, you are a testimony of the things God has given you. You are a testimony by knowing and living his scripture. The scripture is the new wine. A drunkard does not desire to fill his body with the new wine of God's Scripture. A

- drunkard desires the old wine. The drunkard is the old bottle. When you repent and turn from your sin, you are the new bottle. New wine will be preserved in the new bottle.
- Matthew 9:17 Neither do men put new wine into old bottles: else the bottles break, and the wine runneth out, and the bottles perish: but they put new wine into new bottles, and both are preserved.
- Mark 2:22 And no man putteth new wine into old bottles: else the new wine doth burst the bottles, and the wine is spilled, and the bottles will be marred: but new wine must be put into new bottles.
- Luke 5:37-39 And no man putteth new wine into old bottles; else
  the new wine will burst the bottles, and be spilled, and the
  bottles shall perish. But new wine must be put into new
  bottles; and both are preserved. No man also having drunk old
  wine straightway desireth new: for he saith, The old is better.
- A righteous life starts with knowledge of sins of the flesh in the New Testament. Your righteous life in Christ starts by prayer. You repent of your sins and desire to escape the things of the past. The devil is setting snares to pull you back into drunkenness. Judgement day will come upon you when you are least aware. God tells you that you must always be ready. The unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God. These next verses from three witnesses should scare the sinner.
- Matthew 24:48-51 <u>But and if that evil servant shall say in his</u>

  <u>heart, My lord delayeth his coming; And shall begin to smite</u>

  <u>his fellowservants, and to eat and drink with the drunken; The</u>

  <u>lord of that servant shall come in a day when he looketh not</u>

  <u>for him, and in an hour that he is not aware of, And shall cut</u>

  <u>him asunder, and appoint him his portion with the hypocrites:</u>

  there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

- Luke 21:34-36 And take heed to yourselves, lest at any time your hearts be overcharged with surfeiting, and drunkenness, and cares of this life, and so that day come upon you unawares. For as a snare shall it come on all them that dwell on the face of the whole earth. Watch ye therefore, and pray always, that ye may be accounted worthy to escape all these things that shall come to pass, and to stand before the Son of man.
- 1 Corinthians 6:10 Nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners, shall inherit the kingdom of God.
- Galatians 5:21 Envyings, murders, drunkenness, revellings, and such like: of the which I tell you before, as I have also told you in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God.
- Galatians 6:7 Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap.
- When you choose Jesus as your Lord and Savior, you want to live a glorious life, serving him. He does not want you to live a life as a drunkard. Nor does he want you to lead others to drunkenness or to make them stumble. You neither love God, nor your neighbor when you lead them into drunkenness.
- Luke 12:45-46 But and if that servant say in his heart, My lord delayeth his coming; and shall begin to beat the menservants and maidens, and to eat and drink, and to be drunken; The lord of that servant will come in a day when he looketh not for him, and at an hour when he is not aware, and will cut him in sunder, and will appoint him his portion with the unbelievers.
- Habakkuk 2:15 Woe unto him that giveth his neighbour drink, that puttest thy bottle to him, and makest him drunken also, that thou mayest look on their nakedness!

- Romans 14:15-21 But if thy brother be grieved with thy meat, now walkest thou not charitably. Destroy not him with thy meat, for whom Christ died. Let not then your good be evil spoken of: For the kingdom of God is not meat and drink; but righteousness, and peace, and joy in the Holy Ghost. For he that in these things serveth Christ is acceptable to God, and approved of men. Let us therefore follow after the things which make for peace, and things wherewith one may edify another. For meat destroy not the work of God. All things indeed are pure; but it is evil for that man who eateth with offence. It is good neither to eat flesh, nor to drink wine, nor any thing whereby thy brother stumbleth, or is offended, or is made weak.
- Jesus tells you too always be ready for his coming. Make no provision for the flesh.
- Romans 13:13-14 Let us walk honestly, as in the day; not in rioting and drunkenness, not in chambering and wantonness, not in strife and envying. But put ye on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make not provision for the flesh, to fulfil the lusts thereof.
- 1 Corinthians 5:11 But now I have written unto you not to keep company, if any man that is called a brother be a fornicator, or covetous, or an idolater, or a railer, or a drunkard, or an extortioner; with such an one no not to eat.
- A drunkard cannot give glory to God. Submit yourselves to each other in the fear of God and be filled with the Spirit.
- Ephesians 5:18-21 And be not drunk with wine, wherein is excess; but be filled with the Spirit; Speaking to yourselves in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord; Giving thanks always for all things unto God and the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ; Submitting yourselves one to another in the fear of God.

- Repent and pray to God for a change in heart and the power to change your life from drugs and alcohol. Do not keep company with those that do not love God.
- 1 Corinthians 5:11 But now I have written unto you not to keep company, if any man that is called a brother be a fornicator, or covetous, or an idolater, or a railer, or a drunkard, or an extortioner; with such an one no not to eat.
- It is time for you to be smart. Do not be deceived. Do not let the devil devour you.
- Proverbs 20:1 Wine is a mocker, strong drink is raging: and whosoever is deceived thereby is not wise.
- 1 Peter 5:8 Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour:
- It is time for you to be great in the eyes of the Lord. John the Baptist was filled with the Holy Ghost from his mother's womb. He did not drink wine or strong drink. Jesus is the truth. Today, hear and be a doer of God's Word.
- Luke 1:15-16 For he shall be great in the sight of the Lord, and shall drink neither wine nor strong drink; and he shall be filled with the Holy Ghost, even from his mother's womb. And many of the children of Israel shall he turn to the Lord their God.
- John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, <u>I am the way, the truth, and the life:</u> no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.
- John 18:37 Pilate therefore said unto him, Art thou a king then?

  Jesus answered, Thou sayest that I am a king. To this end was I born, and for this cause came I into the world, that I should bear witness unto the truth. Every one that is of the truth heareth my voice.

John 3:21 - <u>But he that doeth truth cometh to the light, that his</u> deeds may be made manifest, that they are wrought in <u>God</u>.

Decision: God hates drunkenness. Sin and drunkenness lead you away from the kingdom of God. A bride of Christ does not walk with the devil. God wants you to be part of his kingdom on earth by believing in Jesus Christ and living a righteous life for him. When you believe in Jesus, you accept by faith that by abiding in his doctrine he offers you the gift of eternal life.

Today, repent of your sins, pray and start your walk with Jesus.

To God be the glory in all you do, Amen

# Chapter 12: Departure

- Bible number for Friday March 29 Departure. On this day, Jesus in the flesh departed from this earth. As you celebrate the death of Jesus on the cross and his burial, may you bury the old sinful you in the flesh and decide to accept the Holy Ghost into your heart. This is mandatory. Fast and pray for the next three days and focus only on turning from your old life. Ask for God's direction on how to live your new life. Get ready for your resurrection.
- It is the devil's plan to win this war against God, by dividing and then conquering the people wanting to be children of God.

  Many times, you are conquered before you even get started! He does this by your ignorance in God's words (Plural). Again, the devil does this by your ignorance in God's words. You will not hear this message in churches today! Why, because churches want the physical you. Being children of God, God only wants one thing, your heart. Jesus gave you two commandments: Love God and love your neighbor. You show your love of God by loving your neighbor! You show your love of neighbor by doing! The Holy Spirit will prick you heart when you hear of an opportunity to serve. Unlike Moses, will you hear Caleb and Joshua's message on the promised land and go conquer your giants. Will you serve God and don't look back?

Deceivers use half a verse to illegally dissect God's word.

2 Timothy 3:16 - All scripture is given by inspiration of God,...

They will say, "If God didn't mean it then he wouldn't have said it."

Ignorant of God's word, they will say, "All you have to do is believe, to be saved. God loves you, so just believe." Any man (i.e. devil) that preaches salvation in a couple of bible verses is blaspheming the Holy Ghost. That is the only unforgiveable sin in the eyes of God!

- Acts 16:31 And they said, Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved, and thy house.
- John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.
- Let's look at a couple of verses. They will say that God demands you get baptized by water.
- Mark 16:16 He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.
- They will say that God demands baptism by water for the remission of sins and you'll receive the Holy Ghost.
- Acts 2:38 Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.
- You know that many witnesses said that Jesus will baptize you with the Holy Ghost. John baptized by water.
- Mark 1:8 I indeed have baptized you with water: but he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost.
- Many witnesses gave a testimony of the Last Supper. Only one witness, Matthew, included that act as stated for the remission of sins. You know that the shed blood of Jesus on the cross was for the remission of your sins.
- Matthew 26:26-29 And as they were eating, Jesus took bread, and blessed it, and brake it, and gave it to the disciples, and said, Take, eat; this is my body. And he took the cup, and gave thanks, and gave it to them, saying, Drink ye all of it; For this is my blood of the new testament, which is shed for many for the remission of sins. But I say unto you, I will not drink

- henceforth of this fruit of the vine, until that day when I drink it new with you in my Father's kingdom.
- Paul tells you that when you accept Christ and believe in him, the baptism by the Holy Ghost will result in you being a new creature! You no longer reside in darkness and sin. The temple of the old man is destroyed.
- 2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.
- 2 Corinthians 6:14 Be ye not unequally yoked together with unbelievers: for what fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness? and what communion hath light with darkness?
- In three days with your belief in God, the shed blood with the removal of your sins and the circumcision of the heart by the Holy Ghost will turn you from your old life and raise you up.
- John 2:19 <u>Jesus answered and said unto them, Destroy this</u> <u>temple, and in three days I will raise it up.</u>

You repent and turn from sin.

- Mark 7:20-23 And he said, <u>That which cometh out of the man</u>, that defileth the man. For from within, out of the heart of men, proceed evil thoughts, adulteries, fornications, murders, <u>Thefts, covetousness, wickedness, deceit, lasciviousness, an evil eye, blasphemy, pride, foolishness: All these evil things come from within, and defile the man.</u>
- The baptism of the Holy Ghost is the act of God circumcising your heart to the truth in God's word. This is a circumcision of your spirit. Not a circumcision of the flesh. Circumcision of the flesh does nothing spiritually.

- Romans 15:8 Now I say that Jesus Christ was a minister of the circumcision for the truth of God, to confirm the promises made unto the fathers:
- With the baptism of the Holy Ghost, the spirit of truth resides in you and cause you to live God's words. He will prick your heart with opportunities to serve him!
- 2 Corinthians 6:16 And what agreement hath the temple of God with idols? for ye are the temple of the living God; as God hath said, I will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their God, and they shall be my people.
- John 16:8-13 And when he is come, he will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment: Of sin, because they believe not on me; Of righteousness, because I go to my Father, and ye see me no more; Of judgment, because the prince of this world is judged. I have yet many things to say unto you, but ye cannot bear them now. Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come.
- In Matthew 26:26-29 (above) Jesus said he will drink no wine until he is in heaven. He is not telling you to drink wine or to drink blood. By God's words, he is telling you not to eat flesh or wine if it causes a brother to be offended.
- Romans 14:21 It is good neither to eat flesh, nor to drink wine, nor any thing whereby thy brother stumbleth, or is offended, or is made weak.
- Jesus is the Living Water. His flesh is the word of God. His blood is the forgiveness of sins. When you love your brother, he dwells in you and you dwell in him, by living a life that gives God the glory.

John 6:55-56 - For my flesh is meat indeed, and my blood is drink indeed. He that eateth my flesh, and drinketh my blood, dwelleth in me, and I in him.

Now for the remainder of 2 Timothy 3:16

2 Timothy 3:16 - ... profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness:

God's words(plural) are profitable for your understanding the life God wants you to live for him. For reproof and correction to turn you from the errors of your sinful past. When you dwell in righteousness, then God the Holy Ghost dwells in you. Do not be deceived. Do not let any man's false doctrine cause you to hate or cause division in God's people. Love your brother and live your life for the glory of God. Depart from your old sinful life and endure to the end, looking forward to being with God in heaven.

Mark 13:13 - And ye shall be hated of all men for my name's sake: but he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved.

# Chapter 13: God Speaks

It is clear from the many lessons from the New Testament, that God did not present the Gospel of Jesus Christ by numbered verses. The bible verses were numbered in 1569. Numbered verses have been used by man to pervert God's doctrine. Man cannot preach by numbers or pluck numbered verses to present false promises of salvation or works of religion to be imposed on man, supposedly as commanded by God. God presented his doctrine by stories and parables, just as he presented the messages in the Old Testament to the Israelites. When you consider that God carved the 10 commandments out of stone and at the same time knew the hearts of the Israels, his message becomes clear. Right this very minute, God knows what is in your heart. He gave all believers the commandments of the New Testament as a guide book into serving him and not to corrupt yourself with the sins of the flesh and serving the devil.

Exodus 32:3-4,7-8,31 - And all the people brake off the golden earrings which were in their ears, and brought them unto Aaron. And he received them at their hand, and fashioned it with a graving tool, after he had made it a molten calf: and they said, These be thy gods, O Israel, which brought thee up out of the land of Egypt. And the Lord said unto Moses, Go, get thee down; for thy people, which thou broughtest out of the land of Egypt, have corrupted themselves: They have turned aside quickly out of the way which I commanded them: they have made them a molten calf, and have worshipped it, and have sacrificed thereunto, and said, These be thy gods, O Israel, which have brought thee up out of the land of Egypt. And Moses returned unto the Lord, and said, Oh, this people have sinned a great sin, and have made them gods of gold.

- The preponderance of evidence testimonies from the eight witnesses of the New Testament has shown you that all eight witnesses preached on a common salvation. God's message of salvation is clear. Believe in Jesus Christ as the Son of God, repent of your sins and be converted or born again as a child of God, live a righteous life doing the will of God by serving him, showing your love for God and neighbor and not abiding in darkness or sin. Religious acts are not required for God's gift. Keep yourself in the love of God, show your faith by your works and Jesus promises you in the end, everlasting life with him in heaven. Jude referred to this as the common salvation. Jude warns you to keep yourself in the love of God, looking for his mercy, unto the end eternal life.
- Jude 1:3,5,21 Beloved, when I gave all diligence to write unto you of the common salvation, it was needful for me to write unto you, and exhort you that ye should earnestly contend for the faith which was once delivered unto the saints. I will therefore put you in remembrance, though ye once knew this, how that the Lord, having saved the people out of the land of Egypt, afterward destroyed them that believed not. Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life.
- The authors of the New Testament presented God's message in stories. Man's false promise of everlasting life by just believing in this one verse from John 3:16 takes on a different meaning when you look at God's message in John 3. Let's look at God's message.
- John 3:1-22,27 There was a man of the Pharisees, named Nicodemus, a ruler of the Jews: The same came to Jesus by night, and said unto him, Rabbi, we know that thou art a teacher come from God: for no man can do these miracles that thou doest, except God be with him. Jesus answered and said

unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God. Nicodemus saith unto him, How can a man be born when he is old? can he enter the second time into his mother's womb, and be born? Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God. That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit. Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again. The wind bloweth where it listeth, and thou hearest the sound thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh, and whither it goeth; so is every one that is born of the Spirit. Nicodemus answered and said unto him, How can these things be? Jesus answered and said unto him, Art thou a master of Israel, and knowest not these things? Verily, verily, I say unto thee. We speak that we do know, and testify that we have seen; and ye receive not our witness. If I have told you earthly things, and ye believe not, how shall ye believe, if I tell you of heavenly things? And no man hath ascended up to heaven, but he that came down from heaven, even the Son of man which is in heaven. And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of man be lifted up: That whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have eternal life. For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved. He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God. And this is the condemnation, that light is come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil. For every one that doeth evil hateth the light, neither cometh to the light, lest his deeds should be reproved. But he that doeth truth cometh to the

light, that his deeds may be made manifest, that they are wrought in God. After these things came Jesus and his disciples into the land of Judaea; and there he tarried with them, and baptized. John answered and said, A man can receive nothing, except it be given him from heaven.

What is God's Message from John 3?

Jesus is from heaven, sent by God, to be the light of the world. You can receive nothing unless it was given to you from God.

It is natural for you to hate the light, love sin and darkness with evil deeds. Men love darkness rather than light.

When you believe on Jesus, you must come to the light and chose the Truth. He came so that you might be saved. You do not come to the light until you understand his gospel. You must recognize that God reproves and hates your evil deeds. You must repent and turn from your sin, with your deeds manifest and wrought in God. When you doeth the truth, then you have come to the light. You must do and walk as Jesus walked on this earth.

You must be born of the spirit, the Holy Ghost. You do not know when or where from which the spirit comes, but when it comes upon you, you know it. When you walk as Jesus walked, then you are baptized with the Holy Ghost.

In closing: God knows what is in your heart. His commandments are for you to choose God and be born again in the spirit. To show your love of God and love of your neighbor! To do his will. To keep yourself in the love of God, with the end, the promise of everlasting life, to be with Jesus and tarry with him in heaven.

# Chapter 14: God Speaks on Baptism

Jesus said, "Take up your cross and follow me." No where in the gospel of Jesus Christ, did he say take up your cross and participate in acts of religion. Jesus says to worship him in spirit and truth. Unless you know the truth, worship of the spirit is random. From the witness of the guy's testimonies in the jail ministry, baptism by water is the most misunderstood act presented in the New Testament. Their addictions are fed by their walk with the devil. Being void of the Holy Ghost, they don't have the power of God in their life. The power of the Holy Ghost is sent only to those that do the will of God, contained in the chapter, Receive ye the Holy Ghost. To those with a repentive heart toward God.

Acts 8:21-22 - Thou hast neither part nor lot in this matter: for thy heart is not right in the sight of God. Repent therefore of this thy wickedness, and pray God, if perhaps the thought of thine heart may be forgiven thee.

Several lessons on baptism as reported by the preponderance of evidence testimonies of the eight witnesses in the New Testament (See "A Bride of Christ" - Baptism PoE). You already know that multiple witnesses have testified that Jesus will baptize with the Holy Ghost! With God's messages presented in parables and stories, let's see what God has to tell you. In this story, Saul prosecuted Christians. He was a Pharisee following the religious traditions of his father. The Pharisees were baptized per the baptism of John, but it did not direct them to follow Jesus! Refusing to understand the truth in God's word, he fought against Jesus. At one point, like Saul, you will be blinded by the light of Jesus Christ, so that you may receive your sight. If you follow his instructions and the will of God, you will receive the gift of the Holy Ghost. Saul DID NOT arise

and get baptized in water. He did the will of God, he got baptized by the Holy Ghost!

Acts 9:3-20 - And as he journeyed, he came near Damascus: and suddenly there shined round about him a light from heaven: And he fell to the earth, and heard a voice saying unto him, Saul, Saul, why persecutest thou me? And he said, Who art thou, Lord? And the Lord said, I am Jesus whom thou persecutest: it is hard for thee to kick against the pricks. And he trembling and astonished said, Lord, what wilt thou have me to do? And the Lord said unto him, Arise, and go into the city, and it shall be told thee what thou must do. And the men which journeyed with him stood speechless, hearing a voice, but seeing no man. And Saul arose from the earth; and when his eyes were opened, he saw no man: but they led him by the hand, and brought him into Damascus. And he was three days without sight, and neither did eat nor drink. And there was a certain disciple at Damascus, named Ananias; and to him said the Lord in a vision, Ananias. And he said, Behold, I am here, Lord. And the Lord said unto him, Arise, and go into the street which is called Straight, and enquire in the house of Judas for one called Saul, of Tarsus: for, behold, he prayeth. And hath seen in a vision a man named Ananias coming in, and putting his hand on him, that he might receive his sight. Then Ananias answered, Lord, I have heard by many of this man, how much evil he hath done to thy saints at Jerusalem: And here he hath authority from the chief priests to bind all that call on thy name. But the Lord said unto him, Go thy way: for he is a chosen vessel unto me, to bear my name before the Gentiles, and kings, and the children of Israel: For I will shew him how great things he must suffer for my name's sake. And Ananias went his way, and entered into the house; and putting his hands on him said, Brother Saul, the Lord, even Jesus, that appeared unto thee in the way as thou camest, hath sent me,

that thou mightest receive thy sight, and be filled with the Holy Ghost. And immediately there fell from his eyes as it had been scales: and he received sight forthwith, and arose, and was baptized. And when he had received meat, he was strengthened. Then was Saul certain days with the disciples which were at Damascus. And straightway he preached Christ in the synagogues, that he is the Son of God.

When you walk with Jesus, he will put you in a place to receive the gift of the Holy Ghost. That place is not where you want to go. It is the place that God directs you. When Jesus was resurrected, he directed the disciples and his followers to the kingdom hall. Lazarus had been threatened for his life. Jesus was crucified over 45 days ago, but for these followers it didn't matter. They came forth on their own free will, to follow Jesus. To congregate and give God the glory. There will be fear of prosecution when you turn to Jesus. There will be fear of isolation, as you must turn from those that abuse the word of God. Knowing that the gift from God is on the horizon, that Holy Ghost will be the power and the engine to allow you to speak the word of God without concern! Above all, only the will of God matters. Addiction and the sins of the flesh, will be but a distant forgotten memory. Let today be your day of Pentecost. Will you allow the word of God to blind you, so that you can see!

Acts 2:1-6 - And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. And suddenly there came a sound from heaven as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting. And there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as of fire, and it sat upon each of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance. And there were dwelling at Jerusalem Jews, devout men, out of every nation under heaven. Now

when this was noised abroad, the multitude came together, and were confounded, because that every man heard them speak in his own language.

Be strong in the faith and the power of God's Word. The devil never lets up. With the power of the Holy Ghost on your side, the devil of sin and drunkenness that seeks to devour you, will be turned away! Now, go be a witness for Jesus Christ.

# Chapter 15: Receive Ye the Holy Ghost

- Once you accept the forgiveness of your past sins by the sacrifice of Jesus on the cross, out of a pure heart, God wants your walk to be pure. God wants you living a righteous life, doing the will of God. Not to be double-minded serving the devil, while thinking or being deceived that you are serving God. The Comforter or the Holy Ghost is a gift sent by God to those that obey the word of God. Not by an act of religion, but out of a repentant heart and obedience to God. With the Holy Ghost residing within you, the fire burns up the old man in the flesh and you are converted or born again as a child of God. That you may have life through Jesus's name.
- Romans 3:25 Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation through faith in his blood, to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God;
- Acts 5:32 And we are his witnesses of these things; and so is also the Holy Ghost, whom God hath given to them that obey him.
- Matthew 3:11- I indeed baptize you with water unto repentance: but he that cometh after me is mightier than I, whose shoes I am not worthy to bear: he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost, and with fire:
- Luke 3:16 John answered, saying unto them all, I indeed baptize you with water; but one mightier than I cometh, the latchet of whose shoes I am not worthy to unloose: he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost and with fire:
- John 1:33 And I knew him not: but he that sent me to baptize with water, the same said unto me, Upon whom thou shalt see the Spirit descending, and remaining on him, the same is he which baptizeth with the Holy Ghost.

- 1 Peter 1:12 Unto whom it was revealed, that not unto themselves, but unto us they did minister the things, which are now reported unto you by them that have preached the gospel unto you with the Holy Ghost sent down from heaven; which things the angels desire to look into.
- The gift of the Holy Ghost will be sent by God when you choose to walk with Jesus. The cloven tongue is evidence of a changed man.
- John 3:8 The wind bloweth where it listeth, and thou hearest the sound thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh, and whither it goeth: so is every one that is born of the Spirit.
- John 3:27 John answered and said, A man can receive nothing, except it be given him from heaven.
- Acts 1:7-8 And he said unto them, It is not for you to know the times or the seasons, which the Father hath put in his own power. But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.
- Acts 2:1-4,17,18 And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. And suddenly there came a sound from heaven as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting. And there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as of fire, and it sat upon each of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance. And it shall come to pass in the last days, saith God, I will pour out of my Spirit upon all flesh: and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams:

- And on my servants and on my handmaidens I will pour out in those days of my Spirit; and they shall prophesy:
- Your life is evidence of the Comforter working in truth in your life.

  Not in sin, but in righteousness giving glory to God. Living unto righteousness is your "do." Your works.
- John 16:7-14 Nevertheless I tell you the truth; It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send him unto you. And when he is come, he will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment: Of sin, because they believe not on me; Of righteousness, because I go to my Father, and ye see me no more; Of judgment, because the prince of this world is judged. I have yet many things to say unto you, but ye cannot bear them now. Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come. He shall glorify me: for he shall receive of mine, and shall shew it unto you.
- Paul was clear in his message to the Romans that when walking in the Spirit, you are free from sin and death. The Spirit has raised you from the dead. You are called according to his purpose.
- Romans 8:1-16,25-28 There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit. For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death. For what the law could not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, God sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh: That the righteousness of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit. For they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh; but they that are after the Spirit the

things of the Spirit. For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace. Because the carnal mind is enmity against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be. So then they that are in the flesh cannot please God. But ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of God dwell in you. Now if any man have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of his. And if Christ be in you, the body is dead because of sin; but the Spirit is life because of righteousness. But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you. Therefore, brethren, we are debtors, not to the flesh, to live after the flesh. For if ye live after the flesh, ve shall die: but if ve through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live. For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God. For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father. The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God: But if we hope for that we see not, then do we with patience wait for it. Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered. And he that searcheth the hearts knoweth what is the mind of the Spirit, because he maketh intercession for the saints according to the will of God. And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose.

You are warned not to fall from you own steadfastness in serving Jesus Christ. Do not partake in sin willfully. You could be in danger of eternal damnation.

- Mark 3:29 <u>But he that shall blaspheme against the Holy Ghost hath never forgiveness, but is in danger of eternal damnation</u>.
- Hebrews 6:4-6 For it is impossible for those who were once enlightened, and have tasted of the heavenly gift, and were made partakers of the Holy Ghost, and have tasted the good word of God, and the powers of the world to come, If they shall fall away, to renew them again unto repentance; seeing they crucify to themselves the Son of God afresh, and put him to an open shame.
- Hebrews 10:26 For if we sin willfully after that we have received the knowledge of the truth, there remaineth no more sacrifice for sins,
- 2 Peter 3:17 Ye therefore, beloved, seeing ye know these things before, beware lest ye also, being led away with the error of the wicked, fall from your own stedfastness.
- Hebrews 10:23 -Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; (for he is faithful that promised;)
- Peter being exposed to the last miracle sent to his Disciples, the Holy Ghost, to all that believed on Jesus, quoted this saying:
- Acts 2:38 Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.
- This verse is often used for water baptism. When you believe in Jesus and in your heart, you recognize that being a witness for Jesus is more important than the fear of persecution by your friends and family, then God sends you the gift of the Holy Ghost. Sent from God and not by the water baptism of man. Let the Holy Ghost sanctify your spirit. Always willing to give witness of your hope in Jesus Christ. To share God's love.

- 1 Peter 1:2,22-23 Elect according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, through sanctification of the Spirit, unto obedience and sprinkling of the blood of Jesus Christ: Grace unto you, and peace, be multiplied. Seeing ye have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren, see that ye love one another with a pure heart fervently: Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever.
- 1 Peter 3:15 But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts: and be ready always to give an answer to every man that asketh you a reason of the hope that is in you with meekness and fear:

# Chapter 16: God Speaks through Peter

- As you study the bible, God presents his doctrine by stories and parables. He did not preach by numbers, by plucking numbered verses combined by man used to pervert God's word.
- Remember, as you study God's word, the witnesses, Matthew, John, Peter, James and Jude are reporting the word of God, first-hand. They walked with Jesus. Take heed to messages from these witnesses.
- Mark, Luke and Paul are second hand reporting. They walked on this earth during time that Jesus walked on the earth. They may have witnessed miracles performed by Jesus, but as far as we know they were not disciples of Jesus. They were like the rest of us. Slow to make a commitment to God on living their life and walking as Jesus walked. Paul, as an arrogant judgmental Pharisee, flatly refusing to follow Jesus. He took it upon himself to prosecute the Christians, until Jesus blinded him with his light. Will you open your eyes, so you too can be blinded by the light of Jesus. To see the Light and follow him.
- John 9:5,39 As long as I am in the world, I am the light of the world. And Jesus said, For judgment I am come into this world, that they which see not might see; and that they which see might be made blind.
- Time after time, Jesus made it clear to Peter, to take up his cross and follow Jesus. Time after time, Jesus has spoken to you, to take up your cross and follow him. Will you accept Jesus and be made blind to the things of this earth, to one living in the spirit and see. To see as Jesus sees. You are chosen to a royal priesthood, chosen out of darkness into the marvelous light of Jesus. Can you see God's directions offered to you in the gospel of Peter?

1 Peter 2:1-25 - Wherefore laying aside all malice, and all guile, and hypocrisies, and envies, and all evil speakings. As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow thereby: If so be ve have tasted that the Lord is gracious. To whom coming, as unto a living stone, disallowed indeed of men, but chosen of God, and precious, Ye also, as lively stones, are built up a spiritual house, an holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices, acceptable to God by Jesus Christ. Wherefore also it is contained in the scripture. Behold, I lay in Sion a chief corner stone, elect, precious: and he that believeth on him shall not be confounded. Unto you therefore which believe he is precious: but unto them which be disobedient, the stone which the builders disallowed, the same is made the head of the corner, And a stone of stumbling, and a rock of offence, even to them which stumble at the word, being disobedient: whereunto also they were appointed. But we are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people: that we should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light: Which in time past were not a people, but are now the people of God: which had not obtained mercy, but now have obtained mercy. Dearly beloved, I beseech you as strangers and pilgrims, abstain from fleshly lusts, which war against the soul: Having your conversation honest among the Gentiles: that, whereas they speak against you as evildoers, they may by your good works, which they shall behold, glorify God in the day of visitation. Submit yourselves to every ordinance of man for the Lord's sake: whether it be to the king, as supreme; Or unto governors, as unto them that are sent by him for the punishment of evildoers, and for the praise of them that do well. For so is the will of God, that with well doing ye may put to silence the ignorance of foolish men: As free, and not using your liberty for a cloke of maliciousness, but as the servants of God. Honour all men. Love the brotherhood. Fear God.

Honour the king. Servants, be subject to your masters with all fear; not only to the good and gentle, but also to the froward. For this is thankworthy, if a man for conscience toward God endure grief, suffering wrongfully. For what glory is it, if, when ve be buffeted for your faults, ye shall take it patiently? but if, when ye do well, and suffer for it, ye take it patiently, this is acceptable with God. For even hereunto were ve called: because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that ve should follow his steps: Who did no sin, neither was guile found in his mouth: Who, when he was reviled, reviled not again: when he suffered, he threatened not; but committed himself to him that judgeth righteously: Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness; by whose stripes ve were healed. For ve were as sheep going astray; but are now returned unto the Shepherd and Bishop of your souls.

What is God's Message thru Peter.

Through Peter, God is telling you put aside your life with the devil and be born again, desiring God's word and to grow in the spirit of the Lord, for he is gracious.

Like Jesus, you are also are a stone chosen of God and precious.

The Holy Ghost builds up your spiritual house as part of a holy priesthood, born to offer up works and spiritual sacrifices to God. Showing forth works and praises of him that has called you out of darkness and into his marvelous light, walking as people of God that have obtained his mercy. May your good works glorify God until the end.

The will of God is for you to silence the ignorance of foolish men and put aside evil and be a servant of God, enduring grief and suffering. Desiring only to follow after the steps of Christ, by following him. He bared your sins on the cross. Now, being

dead to sin, you live a righteous life unto the Lord. Give to Ceasar the things that are Ceasar's and follow the ordinances of man. Abstain from fleshly lusts which war against the Holy Ghost. When you believe on Jesus do not be confused. When you believe you follow his word and you are made head of a corner in God's kingdom.

The disobedient are a stone of stumbling that do not give glory to God by your works.

In closing: God knows what is in your heart. His desire for you is to choose God and be born again in the spirit by showing your love of God and love of your neighbor! To do his will. To walk and keep yourself in the love of God, with the end, the promise of everlasting life, to be with Jesus and tarry with him in heaven.

# Chapter 17: God Speaks through James

- James saw his brother, Jesus, perform miracle after miracle. Stand up to the Pharisees. Persecuted, hung on the cross, died and rose up in the glory of God. It was this final resurrection of Jesus that sanctified the heart of James into a believer of his brother Jesus Christ, as God. When you believe in God, you repent of your sins and turn to him, living a righteous life in the name of Jesus Christ, loving God and loving one another. The book of James captures the message of salvation given to you in the Gospel of Jesus Christ as presented in Matthew, Mark, Luke, John, Paul, Peter and Jude. James's message of salvation is for believers. His book is not salvation for dummies. It is a graduate level course. His gospel specifically states that when you are a believer of Jesus Christ, you show your faith by your works. You live the will of God.
- James 2:26 For as the body without the spirit is dead, so faith without works is dead also.
- His message is for the Hebrews. They knew God, as the creator of all things. James was a servant of God. He taught out of his Gospel. James got it! You show your faith by your works.
- James 1:1 James, a servant of God and of the Lord Jesus Christ, to the twelve tribes which are scattered abroad, greeting.
- To understand the gospel, you must fear God and understand the consequences of not believing and living his Word. The devil will not do the will of God. When you believe, you do the will of God. If you say you believe and walk in sin, then you are doing the will of the devil.
- James 2:19 Thou believest that there is one God; thou doest well: the devils also believe, and tremble.

- Jesus told you of the two great commandments. Love God. Love you neighbor as yourself. Your faith is sanctified by the love you show to others.
- James 2:1,5,8,10 My brethren, have not the faith of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Lord of glory, with respect of persons. Hearken, my beloved brethren, Hath not God chosen the poor of this world rich in faith, and heirs of the kingdom which he hath promised to them that love him? If ye fulfil the royal law according to the scripture, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself, ye do well: For whosoever shall keep the whole law, and yet offend in one point, he is guilty of all.
- When you first believe from the heart, the devil will be all over you.

  The devil wants you back. Resist those temptations and let your faith be perfect, wanting no one but Jesus.
- James 1:2-4 My brethren, count it all joy when ye fall into divers temptations; Knowing this, that the trying of your faith worketh patience. But let patience have her perfect work, that ye may be perfect and entire, wanting nothing.
- Repent and turn from your sinful ways. Deciding never to return to that sinful existence walking with the devil. Endure temptation and the Lord has promised you the crown of life, (everlasting life in heaven) for those that love him. Only the Lord can save your souls.
- James 1:12,21-22,27 Blessed is the man that endureth temptation: for when he is tried, he shall receive the crown of life, which the Lord hath promised to them that love him. Wherefore lay apart all filthiness and superfluity of naughtiness, and receive with meekness the engrafted word, which is able to save your souls. But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves. Pure religion and undefiled before God and the Father is this, To visit the

- fatherless and widows in their affliction, and to keep himself unspotted from the world.
- Living and doing the will of God for the glory of God. Visiting and applying fervent acts of charity. When you fail to live your faith, you deny God. Jesus died for your sins and yet you cannot lift one little finger to give God the glory. When you fail to serve God, it is sin.
- James 4:17 Therefore to him that knoweth to do good, and doeth it not, to him it is sin.
- God sent Jesus, to instruct you on how to live a righteous life unto the Lord. You are his creature.
- James 1:18 Of his own will begat he us with the word of truth, that we should be a kind of firstfruits of his creatures.
- Let the word of God direct you. Word by word, verse by verse and with the power of God, may God's Word turn you from sin and misery.
- James 3:3 Behold, we put bits in the horses' mouths, that they may obey us; and we turn about their whole body.
- You cannot serve the devil and God. You must choose. It is only when you choose God, will your life begin to change. No longer unstable and bending with the wind and desires of the devil, but focused on the things of God.
- James 1:8 A double minded man is unstable in all his ways.
- You are walking with the Lord, basting in his glory. Remember the commandments of Jesus and his last words to Peter, "Feed my sheep." Let works, serving man and God, and sharing God's word then sanctify your hearts. To reinforce your faith by works.

- James 2:17-19,21-24 Even so faith, if it hath not works, is dead, being alone. Yea, a man may say, Thou hast faith, and I have works: shew me thy faith without thy works, and I will shew thee my faith by my works. Thou believest that there is one God; thou doest well: the devils also believe, and tremble. Was not Abraham our father justified by works, when he had offered Isaac his son upon the altar? Seest thou how faith wrought with his works, and by works was faith made perfect? And the scripture was fulfilled which saith, Abraham believed God, and it was imputed unto him for righteousness: and he was called the Friend of God. Ye see then how that by works a man is justified, and not by faith only.
- No longer lusting for the things of this earth and free from sin.

  Draw nigh to God and he will draw nigh to you. Pray.
- James 4:2-8, 10 Ye lust, and have not: ye kill, and desire to have, and cannot obtain: ye fight and war, yet ye have not, because ye ask not. Ye ask, and receive not, because ye ask amiss, that ye may consume it upon your lusts. Ye adulterers and adulteresses, know ye not that the friendship of the world is enmity with God? whosoever therefore will be a friend of the world is the enemy of God. Do ye think that the scripture saith in vain, The spirit that dwelleth in us lusteth to envy? But he giveth more grace. Wherefore he saith, God resisteth the proud, but giveth grace unto the humble. Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. Draw nigh to God, and he will draw nigh to you. Cleanse your hands, ye sinners; and purify your hearts, ye double minded. Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and he shall lift you up.
- James 5:15 And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him.

- Seek fellowship with believers. Confess your faults and challenge one another to live your lives in the glory of God.
- James 5:16 Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much.
- God gives glory to those that spread his word.
- James 5:20 Let him know, that he which converteth the sinner from the error of his way shall save a soul from death, and shall hide a multitude of sins.
- All wisdom from above is pure. Enjoy the fruits of the Spirit, endure to the end with the crown of life or the life everlasting with Jesus.
- James 3:17-18 But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, and easy to be intreated, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality, and without hypocrisy. And the fruit of righteousness is sown in peace of them that make peace.

#### Chapter 18: Sabbath

- Why the sabbath? Jesus was a rebel when it came to the sabbath in the New Testament. Let's examine the sabbath in the bible. God's seventh commandment was clear, to keep the sabbath holv.
- Exodus 20:1,6,8 And God spake all these words, saying, And shewing mercy unto thousands of them that love me, and keep my commandments. Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy.
- God created the heavens and the earth. He created man on the sixth day. On the seventh day he rested. Moses had to wait six days before he was allowed to go up to Mount Sinai to meet God on the seventh day. A Hebrew slave was to serve for six years and in the seventh year he was to be set free. The sabbath was at the end of the week. Check your calendar. That would be on Saturday.
- In bible numbers: Seven Completion, Spiritual Perfection.
- The sabbath was the day of completion. God worked for six days and he rested on the seventh. As mighty as he is, he rested on the seventh. He looked at what he had just completed and said it is good. In his simplest of commandments, he wants you to look back upon the week you have worked and review the blessings that he has given you and for you to say, "it is good". He wants you to plan a day of rest on the sabbath, refrain from self and just give glory to the Lord, thy God.
- The simplest of the commands to keep the sabbath holy is between you and God. The religious leader had a different plan. They didn't think you would know how to rest and give glory to God, so you had to abide by their rules! To witness their sacrifices.
- Jesus performed many miracles and healed many lost and diseased people on the sabbath. To heal them and to grow his heavenly

- kingdom, all for the glory of God. Not for the glory of the Pharisees!
- Matthew 12:10-13 And, behold, there was a man which had his hand withered. And they asked him, saying, Is it lawful to heal on the sabbath days? that they might accuse him. And he said unto them, What man shall there be among you, that shall have one sheep, and if it fall into a pit on the sabbath day, will he not lay hold on it, and lift it out? How much then is a man better than a sheep? Wherefore it is lawful to do well on the sabbath days. Then saith he to the man, Stretch forth thine hand. And he stretched it forth; and it was restored whole, like as the other.
- Mark 3:1-6 And he entered again into the synagogue; and there was a man there which had a withered hand. And they watched him, whether he would heal him on the sabbath day; that they might accuse him. And he saith unto the man which had the withered hand, <a href="Standforth">Stand forth</a>. And he saith unto them, Is it lawful to do good on the sabbath days, or to do evil? to save life, or to kill? But they held their peace. And when he had looked round about on them with anger, being grieved for the hardness of their hearts, he saith unto the man, <a href="Stretch forth">Stretch forth</a> thine hand. And he stretched it out: and his hand was restored whole as the other. And the Pharisees went forth, and straightway took counsel with the Herodians against him, how they might destroy him.
- Luke 13:14 And the ruler of the synagogue answered with indignation, because that Jesus had healed on the sabbath day, and said unto the people, There are six days in which men ought to work: in them therefore come and be healed, and not on the sabbath day.
- Needless to say, the Pharisees objected. They perceived that it was your duty to witness their works and offerings on the sabbath.

  As directed by the ten commandments, the sabbath was no

- longer about loving God or neighbor, but loving the worship of man. Jesus wanted to make a point. All four witnesses gave testimony after testimony of Jesus giving glory to the Father on the sabbath, by showing acts of love to the things of God. Not to the things of self, but to the love of others. To let your light shine before men.
- Mark 3:4 And he saith unto them, <u>Is it lawful to do good on the sabbath days</u>, or to do evil? to save life, or to kill? But they held their peace.
- Mark 12:33 And to love him with all the heart, and with all the understanding, and with all the soul, and with all the strength, and to love his neighbour as himself, is more than all whole burnt offerings and sacrifices.
- John 5:5-9,10,16 And a certain man was there, which had an infirmity thirty and eight years. When Jesus saw him lie, and knew that he had been now a long time in that case, he saith unto him, Wilt thou be made whole? The impotent man answered him, Sir, I have no man, when the water is troubled, to put me into the pool: but while I am coming, another steppeth down before me. Jesus saith unto him, Rise, take up thy bed, and walk. And immediately the man was made whole, and took up his bed, and walked: and on the same day was the sabbath. The Jews therefore said unto him that was cured, It is the sabbath day: it is not lawful for thee to carry thy bed. And therefore did the Jews persecute Jesus, and sought to slay him, because he had done these things on the sabbath day.
- John 9:14 And it was the sabbath day when Jesus made the clay, and opened his eyes.
- Matthew 5:16 <u>Let your light so shine before men, that they may</u> see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.

- The Pharisees, perceived that only their works and your worship at the temple gave glory to God. Jesus made it clear to them that acts of mercy and taking care of the things of God, also gave glory to God. By doing what God has directed, you get to know him and his mission. You follow him and he gets to know you.
- John 7:23 If a man on the sabbath day receive circumcision, that the law of Moses should not be broken; are ye angry at me, because I have made a man every whit whole on the sabbath day?
- God is Lord, even on the sabbath.
- Mark 2:27-28 And he said unto them, <u>The sabbath was made for man, and not man for the sabbath:</u> Therefore the Son of man is Lord also of the sabbath.
- How you spend your sabbath, serving God is between you and God. Reset your goals. Rest and use the sabbath as a day of learning God's word. To seek the kingdom of God. Th hear God's word at church and be with believers. To love God and to love your neighbor. Complete your week of work and on the sabbath provide a day of spiritual perfection for the Lord. Steer from self and plan on celebrating with your blessings, your loved ones, work at a soup kitchen, volunteer and love on God and people as Jesus loved. To take up your cross and follow him and seek the kingdom of God. Do not turn your day of rest into a day of worshipping idols for self!
- Luke 12:31, 34 <u>But rather seek ye the kingdom of God; and all</u> these things shall be added unto you. For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also.
- With your heart right with God, you seek to please him and give him the glory in all that you do.
- To God be the glory in all you do, Amen.

# Chapter 19: The Enemy

- Who is your enemy? Your enemies are those that refuse to do the will of God. Those that betray the gospel of Jesus Christ.
- John 13:1-2 Now before the feast of the passover, when Jesus knew that his hour was come that he should depart out of this world unto the Father, having loved his own which were in the world, he loved them unto the end. And supper being ended, the devil having now put into the heart of Judas Iscariot, Simon's son, to betray him;
- Your enemies are those that worship the things of the devil. The devil makes war with the saints.
- Revelation 13:7-9 And it was given unto him to make war with the saints, and to overcome them: and power was given him over all kindreds, and tongues, and nations. And all that dwell upon the earth shall worship him, whose names are not written in the book of life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world. If any man have an ear, let him hear.
- Your enemy is sin and those being filled with all unrighteousness.

  Those who partake of your addiction are your enemy. Those who worship false gods are thin on the desire to understand God's word and can be swept away by the devil.
- Romans 1:29-32 Being filled with all unrighteousness, fornication, wickedness, covetousness, maliciousness; full of envy, murder, debate, deceit, malignity; whisperers, Backbiters, haters of God, despiteful, proud, boasters, inventors of evil things, disobedient to parents, Without understanding, covenant breakers, without natural affection, implacable, unmerciful: Who knowing the judgment of God, that they which commit such things are worthy of death, not only do the same, but have pleasure in them that do them.

- Luke 8:12 Those by the way side are they that hear; then cometh the devil, and taketh away the word out of their hearts, lest they should believe and be saved.
- 1 John 3:10-11 In this the children of God are manifest, and the children of the devil: whosoever doeth not righteousness is not of God, neither he that loveth not his brother.

Your enemy is not God.

- John 8:49-51 Jesus answered, <u>I have not a devil; but I honour my</u>
  <u>Father, and ye do dishonour me</u>. And I seek not mine own
  glory: there is one that seeketh and judgeth. Verily, verily, I
  <u>say unto you</u>, If a man keep my saying, he shall never see
  death.
- Your enemy is not the lost. God wants you to love and share the gospel with the lost.
- 2 Corinthians 4:3-4 But if our gospel be hid, it is hid to them that are lost: In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them.
- Be strong in the faith and the power of God's Word. Your enemy is the devil. The devil never lets up. The devil of sin and drunkenness will seek to devour you!
- 1 Peter 5:8 Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour:
- Ephesians 6:10-18,23-24 Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might. Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high

places. Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness; And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace; Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked. And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God: Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints; Peace be to the brethren, and love with faith, from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. Grace be with all them that love our Lord Jesus Christ in sincerity. Amen.

Your enemies have no desire for you to live a life taking care of your family and the things of God. Your enemies have no desire to help you turn from your addiction. Your enemy is the devil. At some point you have to decide if you want to walk with the enemy or serving the things of God. Just say no to the enemy, turn and brush the dust from your feet for a testimony against the devil.

Matthew 10:14 - <u>And whosoever shall not receive you, nor hear</u>
your words, when ye depart out of that house or city, shake off
the dust of your feet

Mark 6:11 - And whosoever shall not receive you, nor hear you, when ye depart thence, shake off the dust under your feet for a testimony against them. Verily I say unto you, It shall be more tolerable for Sodom and Gomorrha in the day of judgment, than for that city.

- Luke 9:5 KJV And whosoever will not receive you, when ye go out of that city, shake off the very dust from your feet for a testimony against them.
- Your only power over the devil, is through Jesus Christ powered by the Holy Ghost! Follow him and he will deliver you.
- Acts 10:38 How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him.
- Matthew 4:12,17,19,22-25 Now when Jesus had heard that John was cast into prison, he departed into Galilee; From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, Repent: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand. And he saith unto them, Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men. And they immediately left the ship and their father, and followed him. And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all manner of sickness and all manner of disease among the people. And his fame went throughout all Syria: and they brought unto him all sick people that were taken with divers diseases and torments, and those which were possessed with devils, and those which were lunatick, and those that had the palsy; and he healed them. And there followed him great multitudes of people from Galilee, and from Decapolis, and from Jerusalem, and from Judaea, and from beyond Jordan.

# Chapter 20: I'm Saved

In my witnessing I've hear this phrase from people of all religious denominations. In the Old Testament and most of the New Testament, God's chosen people used this verse to reflect on God's protection from their enemies. Many churches are now saying that you can be saved. My brother-in-law passed and I was asked if he was saved! By now it should be evident that when you die, you will stand before God. Only God knows if you did the will of God. If you are saved or not.

Let's look at the preponderance of evidence testimonies from the eight witnesses that are used to develop the gospel of Jesus Christ and living your life per the will of God with the end, everlasting life. My life has been used studying and apply contracts for business and personal life. I approach every contract with this caution: "If it sounds too good to be true, well then it is likely not true." Three years ago, the Holy Ghost convicted me to act on a church that quoted several verses from Romans and promised people everlasting life without repentance, by believing in Jesus and saying a prayer to save you with the promise of everlasting life in heaven. God took care of me and told me to teach the truth in his Word. (See "A **Bride of Christ**"- Miracles). Time after time, these "saved" individuals did not experience a change of heart. They had no knowledge of the doctrine of Jesus Christ. They did not experience a converted or born-again relationship with Jesus and continued their life of sin. Randy has been living a life walking with the devil, being deceived by man. (See "A Bride of Christ" - Three Witnesses). Jesus is warning you that you must have a change of heart from sin and to be born again as a child of God. (See "A Bride of Christ" - Converted)

John 3:3 - Jesus answered and said unto him, <u>Verily</u>, <u>Verily</u>, <u>I say</u> unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.

- Paul was converted on his way to Damascus from a lover of religious practices to a lover of Jesus. Works by animal sacrifices could never forgive sin and are not required for salvation offered by Jesus Christ. The eight New Testament authors or witnesses wrote 27 books. Of which, Paul wrote 14 books and 100 chapters in the New Testament. As a single witness, Paul wrote the most. His epistles caution you to avoid special interpretation or adhere to false doctrine.
- 2 Timothy 4:3-5 For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears; And they shall turn away their ears from the truth, and shall be turned unto fables. But watch thou in all things, endure afflictions, do the work of an evangelist, make full proof of thy ministry.
- Paul ministered the gospel of Jesus Christ with a vengeance, enduring till the end.
- 2 Corinthians 11:23-27 Are they ministers of Christ? (I speak as a fool) I am more; in labours more abundant, in stripes above measure, in prisons more frequent, in deaths oft. Of the Jews five times received I forty stripes save one. Thrice was I beaten with rods, once was I stoned, thrice I suffered shipwreck, a night and a day I have been in the deep; In journeyings often, in perils of waters, in perils of robbers, in perils by mine own countrymen, in perils by the heathen, in perils in the city, in perils in the wilderness, in perils in the sea, in perils among false brethren; In weariness and painfulness, in watchings often, in hunger and thirst, in fastings often, in cold and nakedness.
- The "I'm saved" teaching always comes from reading specific verses and then telling you what it means. Here is a verse of the "I'm saved" teaching, "No Man can pluck you from my hands."

  Let's look at the whole verse. Jesus is telling you in these verses that you hear and know his word, he knows you and you follow

- him. He knows you because, you are not living your life for the devil. You follow his doctrine. God sent me a witness during this time period. I witnessed to a pastor and out of the blue, he gave me a lesson on John 10: 27-28. He told me that you can pluck yourself from Jesus's hand and no longer follow him.
- John 10:27-28 My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me: And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand.
- Here is another verse of the "I'm saved" teachers. This Roman soldier did not know the gospel of Jesus Christ. The first missionary, Paul, was just on his way to Rome. The Roman soldier only knew that the God of Israel saved his people from their enemies. God had just saved Paul and Silas from death by releasing them from jail. (See "A Bride of Christ" Saved PoE).
- Acts 16:30-31 And brought them out, and said, Sirs, what must I do to be saved? And they said, Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved, and thy house.
- It is the devil's plan to take the gift of everlasting life that only God can promise and then pervert God's judgment. (See "A Bride of Christ" Judgement POE).
- Proverb 17:23 A wicked man taketh a gift out of the bosom to pervert the ways of judgment.
- It is the devil's plan to have deceivers pick and choose or even misquote verses and then convince you that you are saved and always saved. The devil will also tell you that if you don't believe in "I'm saved" verses, then you are stupid, lost and going to hell. When you apply the "I'm saved" belief, then God's word is mute. There is no reason to follow Jesus. No reason to be born again, as a new man with a converted heart. No reason to follow the commandments of God. No reason to

love your neighbor. No reason to love God. There is no reason to avoid the sins of the flesh. No reason to feel sorrow for your sins. No reason to partake of religious services and enjoy the fellowship of Christians. No reason to pray. There is no reason to fear God. No reason to serve God. No reason to preach the gospel throughout the world. No reason not to take the mark of beast in the last days. There is no reason to fear death or standing before Jesus Christ on judgement day. There is no reason to fear a life of walking with the devil. There is no reason to be spiritual alive in Christ. God says you will be judged by Jesus Christ, when you stand before him. You must receive his words.

- John 12:48 He that rejecteth me, and receiveth not my words, hath one that judgeth him: the word that I have spoken, the same shall judge him in the last day.
- John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, <u>I am the way, the truth, and the</u> life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.
- 1 Timothy 2:5 For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus;
- When you believe in Jesus, you don't walk in sin and live your life for the glory of the devil. When you are born of God, you don't commit sin. (See "A Bride of Christ" Sin No More).
- 1 John 3:8-9 He that committeth sin is of the devil; for the devil sinneth from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that he might destroy the works of the devil. Whosoever is born of God doth not commit sin; for his seed remaineth in him: and he cannot sin, because he is born of God.
- When you believe in Jesus, you are raised up from the dead. You give him glory by how you live your life.

- 1 Peter 1:21 Who by him do believe in God, that raised him up from the dead, and gave him glory; that your faith and hope might be in God.
- When you believe in Jesus, you are required to make a choice. You follow Jesus or you follow the devil. This is your most important decision. Walking with Jesus and not serving sin versus walking with the devil and serving sin. Your choice. One gives you everlasting life in heaven versus the other in hell.
- Romans 6:6 Knowing this, that our old man is crucified with him, that the body of sin might be destroyed, that henceforth we should not serve sin.
- John 6:66 From that time many of his disciples went back, and walked no more with him.
- The New Testament also tells you not to blaspheme the Holy Ghost.

  The price of blasphemy of the Holy Ghost is death (See "A Bride of Christ" Blaspheme the Holy Ghost POE).
- Mark 3:29 <u>But he that shall blaspheme against the Holy Ghost</u> <u>hath never forgiveness, but is in danger of eternal damnation.</u>
- Both Paul and Peter tell you how to interpret scripture.
- 2 Timothy 3:16 All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness:
- 2 Peter 1:19-21 We have also a more sure word of prophecy; whereunto ye do well that ye take heed, as unto a light that shineth in a dark place, until the day dawn, and the day star arise in your hearts: Knowing this first, that no prophecy of the scripture is of any private interpretation. For the prophecy came not in old time by the will of man: but holy men of God spake as they were moved by the Holy Ghost.
- Paul's epistles do not reflect on the "I'm saved" teaching. Mark and Luke were Paul's disciples. Their gospels do not reflect on the "I'm saved" belief. There is no complete teaching, gospel or

- epistle from two or three witnesses in the New Testament that supports the "I'm saved" fable. James tells you that when you believe, you do. If only three verses from Romans, or etc. saves you and gets you to heaven, then the teaching of all the other seven witnesses are in vain and their followers are going to hell? I don't think so. Paul lived his life for the glory of God and he tells you how to live your life in Jesus Christ.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:16-24 Rejoice evermore. Pray without ceasing. In everything give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you. Quench not the Spirit. Despise not prophesyings. Prove all things; hold fast that which is good. Abstain from all appearance of evil. And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and I pray God your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. Faithful is he that calleth you, who also will do it.
- Now, go live your life unto righteousness for the glory of God. Do his will, endure unto the end and look forward on judgement day standing before Jesus Christ! (See "A Bride of Christ" Saved-PoE). You do not abide in darkness and sin. You keep God's commandments. You do God's will.
- Matthew 7:21 Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.
- Matthew 24:13 <u>But he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved.</u>
- Matthew 25:46 And these shall go away into everlasting punishment: but the righteous into life eternal.
- John 12:46 <u>I am come a light into the world, that whosoever</u> believeth on me should not abide in darkness.
- John 14:15 <u>If ye love me, keep my commandments.</u>

  Only the pure in heart shall see God.

#### Matthew 5:8 - Blessed are the pure in heart: for they shall see God.

1 Peter 1:22 - 1-23 - Seeing ye have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren, see that ye love one another with a pure heart fervently:

#### Chapter 21: Charity

- Jesus was clear in his Gospel. The end of his commandment is charity. It is last to make sure that it is the first you remember. You show you love of him, by loving your neighbor. That was his message from the beginning. There is no greater love for your neighbor, than sharing God's word. You can't say you love God when you give no love to your neighbor. There can be no charity shown, unless you are a doer of his word. Faith without works is dead. Your love of God is shown by faith, hope and charity with the greatest of these is charity. Your faith is shown by your charity.
- 1 Timothy 1:4-5 Neither give heed to fables and endless genealogies, which minister questions, rather than godly edifying which is in faith: so do. Now the end of the commandment is charity out of a pure heart, and of a good conscience, and of faith unfeigned:
- 1 John 3:11 For this is the message that ye heard from the beginning, that we should love one another.
- John 21:17 He saith unto him the third time, Simon, son of Jonas, lovest thou me? Peter was grieved because he said unto him the third time, Lovest thou me? And he said unto him, Lord, thou knowest all things; thou knowest that I love thee. Jesus saith unto him, Feed my sheep.
- 1 John 4:20 If a man say, I love God, and hateth his brother, he is a liar: for he that loveth not his brother whom he hath seen, how can he love God whom he hath not seen?
- James 1:23 For if any be a hearer of the word, and not a doer, he is like unto a man beholding his natural face in a glass:

- James 2:20 But wilt thou know, O vain man, that faith without works is dead?
- 1 Corinthians 13:1-4,8,13 Though I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, and have not charity, I am become as sounding brass, or a tinkling cymbal. And though I have the gift of prophecy, and understand all mysteries, and all knowledge; and though I have all faith, so that I could remove mountains, and have not charity, I am nothing. And though I bestow all my goods to feed the poor, and though I give my body to be burned, and have not charity, it profiteth me nothing. Charity suffereth long, and is kind; charity envieth not; charity vaunteth not itself, is not puffed up, Charity never faileth: but whether there be prophecies, they shall fail; whether there be tongues, they shall cease; whether there be knowledge, it shall vanish away. And now abideth faith, hope, charity, these three; but the greatest of these is charity.
- 1 Corinthians 16:13-14 Watch ye, stand fast in the faith, quit you like men, be strong. Let all your things be done with charity.
- Revelation 2:19 I know thy works, and charity, and service, and faith, and thy patience, and thy works; and the last to be more than the first.
- Jesus shared his parable of the Samaritan helping the man that was robbed, as a fervent act of charity. There can be no greater act of love, than serving your fellow man out of charity.
- Luke 10:27-36 And he answering said, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy strength, and with all thy mind; and thy neighbour as thyself. And he said unto him, Thou hast answered right: this do, and thou shalt live. But he, willing to justify himself, said unto Jesus, And who is my neighbour? And Jesus answering said, A certain man went down from Jerusalem to Jericho, and fell

among thieves, which stripped him of his raiment, and wounded him, and departed, leaving him half dead. And by chance there came down a certain priest that way: and when he saw him, he passed by on the other side. And likewise a Levite, when he was at the place, came and looked on him, and passed by on the other side. But a certain Samaritan, as he journeyed, came where he was: and when he saw him, he had compassion on him, And went to him, and bound up his wounds, pouring in oil and wine, and set him on his own beast, and brought him to an inn, and took care of him. And on the morrow when he departed, he took out two pence, and gave them to the host, and said unto him, Take care of him; and whatsoever thou spendest more, when I come again, I will repay thee. Which now of these three, thinkest thou, was neighbour unto him that fell among the thieves?

Jude is but one chapter in the New Testament. He even knew your faith is shown by acts of charity.

Jude 1:12-13 - These are spots in your feasts of charity, when they feast with you, feeding themselves without fear: clouds they are without water, carried about of winds; trees whose fruit withereth, without fruit, twice dead, plucked up by the roots; Raging waves of the sea, foaming out their own shame; wandering stars, to whom is reserved the blackness of darkness for ever.

Peter says to have fervent charity.

- Titus 2:2 That the aged men be sober, grave, temperate, sound in faith, in charity, in patience.
- 1 Peter 4:7-8 But the end of all things is at hand: be ye therefore sober, and watch unto prayer. And above all things have fervent charity among yourselves: for charity shall cover the multitude of sins.

- Out of charity, your bond of perfection shows that you understand God doctrine. You and the Lord are one.
- Colossians 3:14-15 And above all these things put on charity, which is the bond of perfectness. And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to the which also ye are called in one body; and be ye thankful.
- Charity doesn't bloat your ego. It edifies your relationship with
- 1 Corinthians 8:1 Now as touching things offered unto idols, we know that we all have knowledge. Knowledge puffeth up, but charity edifieth.
- Decide today, to serve God through charity toward you neighbor. Be a doer of God's word.
- 2 Timothy 2:22 Flee also youthful lusts: but follow righteousness, faith, charity, peace, with them that call on the Lord out of a pure heart.
- As a bride of Christ, starting today, look for opportunities to love God. To love your neighbor. To share God's word. Share God's blessing out of a pure heart.
- 1 Corinthians 16:14 Let all your things be done with charity.
- To God be the glory in all you do, Amen.

# Chapter 22: Salvation - Preponderance of Evidence

- Salvation is the terms of the New Testament contract between you and God. Scripture is not open to private interpretation. A deceiver cannot take one or several verses out of context and come up with a false message of salvation.
- 2 Peter 1:20 Knowing this first, that no prophecy of the scripture is of any private interpretation.
- Righteousness is living your life in the love of others and the things of God, through understanding his word. Not in drunkenness and addiction, worshipping self and the god of greed.
- Luke 21:34 And take heed to yourselves, lest at any time your hearts be overcharged with surfeiting, and drunkenness, and cares of this life, and so that day come upon you unawares.
- What God's message of salvation in the New Testament? A preponderance of evidence will point to God's gift of everlasting life in heaven as told by the witnesses.

#### Case testimony:

Is everlasting life in heaven available to the children of this world?

Jude 1:3,5,21 - Beloved, when I gave all diligence to write unto you of the common salvation, it was needful for me to write unto you, and exhort you that ye should earnestly contend for the faith which was once delivered unto the saints. I will therefore put you in remembrance, though ye once knew this, how that the Lord, having saved the people out of the land of Egypt, afterward destroyed them that believed not. Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life.

- John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.
- John 5:39 <u>Search the scriptures</u>; for in them ye think ye have eternal life: and they are they which testify of me.
- Acts 16:31 And they said, Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved, and thy house.
- Luke 1:77-79 To give knowledge of salvation unto his people by the remission of their sins, Through the tender mercy of our God; whereby the dayspring from on high hath visited us, To give light to them that sit in darkness and in the shadow of death, to guide our feet into the way of peace.
- Matthew 25:46 And these shall go away into everlasting punishment: but the righteous into life eternal.
- Ephesians 2:8-9 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast.
- 2 Timothy 3:15 And that from a child thou hast known the holy scriptures, which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus.
- James 2:18- Yea, a man may say, Thou hast faith, and I have works: shew me thy faith without thy works, and I will shew thee my faith by my works.
- James 2:23-24 And the scripture was fulfilled which saith,
  Abraham believed God, and it was imputed unto him for
  righteousness: and he was called the Friend of God. Ye see
  then how that by works a man is justified, and not by faith only

- Do you have to understand sin, repent and turn from your sin for this gift?
- Matthew 4:17 From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, Repent: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.
- Mark 1:15 And saying, <u>The time is fulfilled</u>, and the kingdom of God is at hand: repent ye, and believe the gospel.
- Luke 13:3 I tell you, <u>Nay: but, except ye repent, ye shall all</u> likewise perish.
- Luke 24:47 And that repentance and remission of sins should be preached in his name among all nations, beginning at Jerusalem.
- Romans 6:6,22-23 Knowing this, that our old man is crucified with him, that the body of sin might be destroyed, that henceforth we should not serve sin. But now being made free from sin, and become servants to God, ye have your fruit unto holiness, and the end everlasting life. For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.
- 2 Peter 3:9 The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.
- *Is living a righteous life required for this gift?*
- John 3:3- Jesus answered and said unto him, <u>Verily, Verily, I say</u> unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.
- Matthew 7:21 Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.

- 1 Peter 1:22-23 Seeing ye have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren, see that ye love one another with a pure heart fervently: Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever.
- John 12:46 I am come a light into the world, that whosoever believeth on me should not abide in darkness.
- Matthew 24:4,13-14 And Jesus answered and said unto them,

  <u>Take heed that no man deceive you. But he that shall endure</u>

  <u>unto the end, the same shall be saved. And this gospel of the</u>

  <u>kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto</u>

  all nations; and then shall the end come.
- Mark 10:25 It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle, than for a rich man to enter into the kingdom of God.
- Mark 13:13 And ye shall be hated of all men for my name's sake: but he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved.
- Luke 21:36 Watch ye therefore, and pray always, that ye may be accounted worthy to escape all these things that shall come to pass, and to stand before the Son of man.
- James 1:12 Blessed is the man that endureth temptation: for when he is tried, he shall receive the crown of life, which the Lord hath promised to them that love him.
- James 1:27 Pure religion and undefiled before God and the Father is this, To visit the fatherless and widows in their affliction, and to keep himself unspotted from the world.
- 1 Peter 4:6-8 For for this cause was the gospel preached also to them that are dead, that they might be judged according to men in the flesh, but live according to God in the spirit. But the end of all things is at hand: be ye therefore sober, and watch

- unto prayer. And above all things have fervent charity among yourselves: for charity shall cover the multitude of sins.
- Decision: You are the jury. God's message of salvation is clear.

  Believe in God, repent of your sins and be converted or born again as a child of God. Live a righteous life by doing the will of God by serving and showing your love for God and neighbor and not abiding in darkness or sin. Religious acts are not required for God's gift. Keep yourself in the love of God, show your faith by your works and Jesus promises you in the end, everlasting life with him in heaven.
- 1 Corinthians 1:17 For Christ sent me not to baptize, but to preach the gospel: not with wisdom of words, lest the cross of Christ should be made of none effect.
- It is clear that God does not offer salvation in terms of a verse or two from the bible. A wicked doer would take heed and be an abomination in the sight of the Lord. The wicked man handling out salvation by several verses of the bible would pervert the ways of God's judgement.
- Proverbs 17:4,23-24 A wicked doer giveth heed to false lips; and a liar giveth ear to a naughty tongue. A merry heart doeth good like a medicine: but a broken spirit drieth the bones. A wicked man taketh a gift out of the bosom to pervert the ways of judgment. Wisdom is before him that hath understanding; but the eyes of a fool are in the ends of the earth.

Keep yourself in the love of God.

#### Chapter 23: Will of God - Preponderance of Evidence

- Jesus is the author and finisher of your faith. Not by the blood of bulls or goats, but eternal life, promised by the sanctification of Jesus through his blood, burial and resurrection. Three days is all it took and the dead works of religion is destroyed. A promise of eternal inheritance offered by Jesus. A promise made to those that obey him and do the will of God.
- Hebrews 5:5,8-9 So also Christ glorified not himself to be made an high priest; but he that said unto him, Thou art my Son, today have I begotten thee. Though he were a Son, yet learned he obedience by the things which he suffered; And being made perfect, he became the author of eternal salvation unto all them that obey him;
- Hebrews 9:11-15 But Christ being come an high priest of good things to come, by a greater and more perfect tabernacle, not made with hands, that is to say, not of this building; Neither by the blood of goats and calves, but by his own blood he entered in once into the holy place, having obtained eternal redemption for us. For if the blood of bulls and of goats, and the ashes of an heifer sprinkling the unclean, sanctifieth to the purifying of the flesh: How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God? And for this cause he is the mediator of the new testament, that by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions that were under the first testament, they which are called might receive the promise of eternal inheritance.

Hebrews 10:36 - For ye have need of patience, that, after ye have done the will of God, ye might receive the promise.

- God does not want you to worship his word. He wants you to live his word.
- James 1:22-23,27 But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves. For if any be a hearer of the word, and not a doer, he is like unto a man beholding his natural face in a glass: Pure religion and undefiled before God and the Father is this, To visit the fatherless and widows in their affliction, and to keep himself unspotted from the world.
- Thus, this is the will of God. That you believe in Jesus, love God, glorify God, abide by his word, love your neighbor, spread his word and enjoy the gift of everlasting life. The will of God starts by loving God from the heart.
- John 14:23 Jesus answered and said unto him, <u>If a man love me</u>, <u>he will keep my words: and my Father will love him, and we</u> <u>will come unto him, and make our abode with him.</u>
- John 8:31-32,47,51 Then said Jesus to those Jews which believed on him, If ye continue in my word, then are ye my disciples indeed; And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free. He that is of God heareth God's words: ... Verily, verily, I say unto you, If a man keep my saying, he shall never see death.
- Matthew 22:14,29,37-39 For many are called, but few are chosen.

  Jesus answered and said unto them, Ye do err, not knowing the scriptures, nor the power of God. Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. This is the first and great commandment. And the second is like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.
- Proverbs 23:12 Apply thine heart unto instruction, and thine ears to the words of knowledge.

- Jesus is the Word. He came to save the lost. You must choose Jesus Christ to enter into the kingdom of God. You must believe as a child. Humble yourself, believe and purify your heart.
- Matthew 18:3,11 And said, Verily I say unto you, Except ye be converted, and become as little children, ye shall not enter into the kingdom of heaven. For the Son of man is come to save that which was lost.
- Matthew 23:11-12 <u>But he that is greatest among you shall be your servant.</u> And whosoever shall exalt himself shall be abased; and he that shall humble himself shall be exalted.
- James 4:4,6-8,10 Ye adulterers and adulteresses, know ye not that the friendship of the world is enmity with God? whosoever therefore will be a friend of the world is the enemy of God. But he giveth more grace. Wherefore he saith, God resisteth the proud, but giveth grace unto the humble. Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. Draw nigh to God, and he will draw nigh to you. Cleanse your hands, ye sinners; and purify your hearts, ye double minded. Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and he shall lift you up.
- When you believe on Jesus, you believe on his doctrine and you follow him. Worship God on spirit and truth.
- John 4:24 God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth.
- John 10:27,28- My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me: And I give unto them eternal life;
- Luke 6:49 <u>But he that heareth, and doeth not, is like a man that</u>
  without a foundation built an house upon the earth; against
  which the stream did beat vehemently, and immediately it fell;
  and the ruin of that house was great.

- Matthew 12:36,50 But I say unto you, <u>That every idle word that</u> men shall speak, they shall give account thereof in the day of judgment. For whosoever shall do the will of my Father which is in heaven, the same is my brother, and sister, and mother.
- When you believe on Jesus, you repent of your sins and turn your life to God. You are born again as a new creature by living a righteous life and avoiding sin. Willing to share the Word of God. Not all will receive you.
- Titus 2:1-2,6,8,10-13 But speak thou the things which become sound doctrine: That the aged men be sober, grave, temperate, sound in faith, in charity, in patience. Young men likewise exhort to be sober minded. Sound speech, that cannot be condemned; that he that is of the contrary part may be ashamed, having no evil thing to say of you. Not purloining, but shewing all good fidelity; that they may adorn the doctrine of God our Saviour in all things. For the grace of God that bringeth salvation hath appeared to all men, Teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly, in this present world; Looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of the great God and our Saviour Jesus Christ;
- Luke 13:3,24 I tell you, Nay: but, except ye repent, ye shall all likewise perish. Strive to enter in at the strait gate: for many, I say unto you, will seek to enter in, and shall not be able.
- John 3:3 Jesus answered and said unto him, <u>Verily</u>, <u>Verily</u>, <u>I say</u> unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.
- John 9:31 Now we know that God heareth not sinners: but if any man be a worshipper of God, and doeth his will, him he heareth.

- 1 Peter 4:2- That he no longer should live the rest of his time in the flesh to the lusts of men, but to the will of God.
- Luke 16:13 No servant can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon.
- Mark 7:13,16,20-23 Making the word of God of none effect through your tradition, which ye have delivered: and many such like things do ye. If any man have ears to hear, let him hear. And he said, That which cometh out of the man, that defileth the man. For from within, out of the heart of men, proceed evil thoughts, adulteries, fornications, murders, Thefts, covetousness, wickedness, deceit, lasciviousness, an evil eye, blasphemy, pride, foolishness: All these evil things come from within, and defile the man.
- Luke 12:8 Also I say unto you, Whosoever shall confess me before men, him shall the Son of man also confess before the angels of God:
- Matthew 28:18-20 And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth. Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you alway, even unto the end of the world. Amen.
- Luke 9:5 And whosoever will not receive you, when ye go out of that city, shake off the very dust from your feet for a testimony against them.
- 1 Peter 2:15 For so is the will of God, that with well doing ye may put to silence the ignorance of foolish men:

- Jesus remembers your work here on earth! Always looking to share the love of God.
- 1 John 2:17 And the world passeth away, and the lust thereof: but he that doeth the will of God abideth for ever.
- Luke 23:42-43 And he said unto Jesus, Lord, remember me when thou comest into thy kingdom. And Jesus said unto him, <u>Verily I say unto thee</u>, To day shalt thou be with me in paradise.
- Matthew 25:31,34-36,40 When the Son of man shall come in his glory, and all the holy angels with him, then shall he sit upon the throne of his glory: Then shall the King say unto them on his right hand, Come, ye blessed of my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world:

  For I was an hungred, and ye gave me meat: I was thirsty, and ye gave me drink: I was a stranger, and ye took me in: Naked, and ye clothed me: I was sick, and ye visited me: I was in prison, and ye came unto me. And the King shall answer and say unto them, Verily I say unto you, In as much as ye have done it unto one of the least of these my brethren, ye have done it unto me.

Always be willing to do the will of God.

Share this book with a lost soul. To that one soul, that is blind or dead in trespasses and sin, you and the Gospel of Jesus Christ could mean the difference between them going to hell or enjoying a victorious life on earth and eternity with Jesus in heaven. This could be the start of their walk with Jesus. Be ready to serve God with a vengeance. Abide in God's word. Accept him today and be ready for a wonderful life.

#### Chapter 24: I was Blind

When you finally understand the simplicity in God's word and the miracle of salvation offered by Jesus Christ, it is as though you were blind and now you see! Ten years ago, that simplicity message hit me like a brick! Over and over again, Jesus restored the sight of blind men by miracles. By faith, he asked them to believe and what he did would give them sight. Exactly the same as his message of salvation in the New Testament. He wants but one thing, for you to serve him by your belief in him. To make his message clear, he performed most of his recorded miracles on the Sabbath. Why? Because he gave you two commandments. Love God and love your neighbor. Showing your love of neighbor by doing his commandments is more important than worshipping the Pharisees. You can now understand why those Pharisees had to get rid of him. Little did they know that Jesus manipulated them into doing God's will. For without their jealously of Jesus's miracles, they would have never crucified him. His shed blood by crucifixion would never have been spread onto the mercy seat of the ark of the covenant. You would never have had your sins forgiven by the blood of Jesus Christ. Salvation for the lost and Gentiles, would have been but a desire of God's. Jesus as God's sacrifice, made it reality.

John 9:5-7,10-11,14-15,24-25 - As long as I am in the world, I am the light of the world. When he had thus spoken, he spat on the ground, and made clay of the spittle, and he anointed the eyes of the blind man with the clay, And said unto him, Go, wash in the pool of Siloam, (which is by interpretation, Sent.) He went his way therefore, and washed, and came seeing. Therefore said they unto him, How were thine eyes opened? He answered and said, A man that is called Jesus made clay, and anointed mine eyes, and said unto me, Go to the pool of Siloam, and wash: and I went and washed, and I received sight.

And it was the sabbath day when Jesus made the clay, and opened his eyes. Then again the Pharisees also asked him how he had received his sight. He said unto them, He put clay upon mine eyes, and I washed, and do see. Then again called they the man that was blind, and said unto him, Give God the praise: we know that this man is a sinner. He answered and said, Whether he be a sinner or no, I know not: one thing I know, that, whereas I was blind, now I see.

Think about this blind man's response after Jesus rubbed spit enriched clay on his eyes and told the blind man to go and wash his eyes: "Go to the pool of Siloam, and wash: and I went and washed, and I received sight. And it was the sabbath day when Jesus made the clay, and opened his eyes." By faith he sent the blind man to wash his eyes from the clay. The blind man, as blind as he was, had to travel to the pool of Siloam and by faith he received his sight. Jesus tells you in his word to believe in his gospel and you will receive your sight and you will understand his word. By living his words, you will receive your sight and your life will be glorious in the eyes of God. The dead will be raised up.

Matthew 11:5 - The blind receive their sight, and the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed, and the deaf hear, the dead are raised up, and the poor have the gospel preached to them.

If an optometrist rubbed clay in your eyes and told you to go to the Ohio River and cleanse the clay from your eyes and for that you would have 20/20 vision, most if not all of you would say that guy is a nut job. You'd wipe your eyes clean in the closest restroom and continue your life as a man with blurred vision. You definitely wouldn't pay him an office visit charge of \$200.

This blind man believed and did what he was told. Jesus is telling you today, to believe in him and your life will change, but will you believe. Will you follow his commandments and do the will of God? Or will you wipe the clay from your eyes and tell God

- that he is a nut job? If you lack the desire to serve God, then you are blind. Jesus purged you of your sins. Will you spend your days worshipping idols or will you serve him, his kingdom and all things of this earth?
- 2 Peter 1:5-9 And beside this, giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue; and to virtue knowledge; And to knowledge temperance; and to temperance patience; and to patience godliness; And to godliness brotherly kindness; and to brotherly kindness charity. For if these things be in you, and abound, they make you that ye shall neither be barren nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ. But he that lacketh these things is blind, and cannot see afar off, and hath forgotten that he was purged from his old sins.
- Is your heart blinded to his word due to the hardness of your hearts?
- Ephesians 4:18 Having the understanding darkened, being alienated from the life of God through the ignorance that is in them, because of the blindness of their heart:
- Can I say that God knows what he is doing! It is a miracle that God has permitted me to see his word! I was blind and now I see.

  Ten years ago, when Jesus hit me with that brick, I had no clue what God had in store for me. Three hundred and fifty bible lessons into a five year jail ministry and I can personally tell you that God rules. Think about this one bible verse he gave me on Saturday at Stonelick Lake.
- James 5:3 Your gold and silver is cankered; and the rust of them shall be a witness against you, and shall eat your flesh as it were fire. Ye have heaped treasure together for the last days.
- How much money and energy do you spend, serving yourself? All your earthly treasure will turn to rust. They are cankered and shall be a witness against you. They shall consume you and keep you from doing the will of God. You come into this world

with nothing and you will leave with nothing. God's word has taught me that the love of stuff will consume you. There will be no happiness in stuff. It will rot away and the destruction of such will be your downfall. Serve God without stuff and the simplicity of your life will be full of blessings and joy.

## Chapter 25: Marriage Supper of the Lamb

- Jesus has called you to the marriage supper of the Lamb. Not because your parents chose Jesus, but because you are choosing him and need him. Will you choose him and only him? To walk as Jesus walked. To love as Jesus loved. To do as Jesus does.
- Revelation 19:9 And he saith unto me, Write, Blessed are they which are called unto the marriage supper of the Lamb. And he saith unto me, These are the true sayings of God.
- Do not be offended by those that you are currently walking with (i.e. friends, family and close associates.) Enamored with the things of this earth, their ignorance, foolishness, lack of knowing God's will and the grip of the devil will try and deter you from a life with Christ. They will speak as evil doers.
- 1 Peter 2:15-16 For so is the will of God, that with well doing ye may put to silence the ignorance of foolish men: As free, and not using your liberty for a cloke of maliciousness, but as the servants of God.
- You were lost and gone astray. Only to return and to come to Jesus as a newborn babe, as a child of God. His invitation is pure.

  His invitation is personal.
- Peter 2:1-25 Wherefore laying aside all malice, and all guile, and hypocrisies, and envies, and all evil speakings, As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow thereby: If so be ye have tasted that the Lord is gracious. To whom coming, as unto a living stone, disallowed indeed of men, but chosen of God, and precious, Ye also, as lively stones, are built up a spiritual house, an holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices, acceptable to God by Jesus Christ. Wherefore also it is contained in the scripture, Behold, I lay in Sion a chief corner stone, elect, precious: and he that believeth on him shall not be confounded. Unto you therefore which

believe he is precious: but unto them which be disobedient, the stone which the builders disallowed, the same is made the head of the corner, And a stone of stumbling, and a rock of offence, even to them which stumble at the word, being disobedient: whereunto also they were appointed. But we are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that we should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light: Which in time past were not a people, but are now the people of God: which had not obtained mercy, but now have obtained mercy. Dearly beloved, I beseech you as strangers and pilgrims, abstain from fleshly lusts, which war against the soul; Having your conversation honest among the Gentiles: that, whereas they speak against you as evildoers, they may by your good works, which they shall behold, glorify God in the day of visitation. Submit yourselves to every ordinance of man for the Lord's sake: whether it be to the king, as supreme; Or unto governors, as unto them that are sent by him for the punishment of evildoers, and for the praise of them that do well. For so is the will of God, that with well doing ye may put to silence the ignorance of foolish men: As free, and not using your liberty for a cloke of maliciousness, but as the servants of God. Honour all men. Love the brotherhood. Fear God. Honour the king. Servants, be subject to your masters with all fear; not only to the good and gentle, but also to the froward. For this is thankworthy, if a man for conscience toward God endure grief, suffering wrongfully. For what glory is it, if, when ve be buffeted for your faults, ye shall take it patiently? but if, when ye do well, and suffer for it, ye take it patiently, this is acceptable with God. For even hereunto were ye called: because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that ye should follow his steps: Who did no sin, neither was guile found in his mouth: Who, when he was reviled, reviled not again; when he suffered, he threatened not; but committed

- himself to him that judgeth righteously: Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed. For ye were as sheep going astray; but are now returned unto the Shepherd and Bishop of your souls.
- In whom you have redemption through his blood, with the forgiveness of your past sins.
- Colossians 1:14 In whom we have redemption through his blood, even the forgiveness of sins
- Romans 3:25 Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation through faith in his blood, to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God;
- Jesus wants you to come and worship God with all that you eat at the marriage supper. Being a fellow servant, walking side by side as a fellow servant worshipping God as a testimony of the word that Jesus gave you.
- Revelation 19:10 And I fell at his feet to worship him. And he said unto me, See thou do it not: I am thy fellowservant, and of thy brethren that have the testimony of Jesus: worship God: for the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy.
- Repent of your sins, daily. To walk as Jesus walked. To take up your cross, follow him in righteousness and seek the kingdom of God.
- Luke 12:31, 34 <u>But rather seek ye the kingdom of God; and all</u>
  <u>these things shall be added unto you.</u> For where your treasure
  <u>is, there will your heart be also.</u>
- With your heart right with God, you seek to please him and give him glory in all that you do. You are his servant. Serving others, as Jesus served. No service is too little. No service is too big. If washing someone's feet gives glory to God, then wash their

- feet. You are to do as Jesus did. Happy are they that do the things that Jesus has done.
- John 13:3-17 Jesus knowing that the Father had given all things into his hands, and that he was come from God, and went to God; He riseth from supper, and laid aside his garments; and took a towel, and girded himself. After that he poureth water into a bason, and began to wash the disciples' feet, and to wipe them with the towel wherewith he was girded. Then cometh he to Simon Peter: and Peter saith unto him, Lord, dost thou wash my feet? Jesus answered and said unto him, What I do thou knowest not now; but thou shalt know hereafter. Peter saith unto him, Thou shalt never wash my feet. Jesus answered him, If I wash thee not, thou hast no part with me. Simon Peter saith unto him, Lord, not my feet only, but also my hands and my head. Jesus saith to him, He that is washed needeth not save to wash his feet, but is clean every whit: and ve are clean, but not all. For he knew who should betray him; therefore said he, Ye are not all clean. So after he had washed their feet, and had taken his garments, and was set down again, he said unto them, Know ye what I have done to you? Ye call me Master and Lord: and ye say well; for so I am. If I then, your Lord and Master, have washed your feet; ye also ought to wash one another's feet. For I have given you an example, that ye should do as I have done to you. Verily, verily, I say unto you, The servant is not greater than his lord; neither he that is sent greater than he that sent him. If ve know these things, happy are ye if ye do them.
- Jesus told you time and time again to use your talents to serve God's kingdom. If your belief, lacks service, then you have no belief. The message of the talents is clear. Use those talents that God has given you.
- Matthew 25:13-30 <u>Watch therefore</u>, for ye know neither the day nor the hour wherein the Son of man cometh. For the

kingdom of heaven is as a man travelling into a far country, who called his own servants, and delivered unto them his goods. And unto one he gave five talents, to another two, and to another one; to every man according to his several ability; and straightway took his journey. Then he that had received the five talents went and traded with the same, and made them other five talents. And likewise he that had received two, he also gained other two. But he that had received one went and digged in the earth, and hid his lord's money. After a long time the lord of those servants cometh, and reckoneth with them. And so he that had received five talents came and brought other five talents, saving, Lord, thou deliveredst unto me five talents: behold, I have gained beside them five talents more. His lord said unto him. Well done, thou good and faithful servant: thou hast been faithful over a few things, I will make thee ruler over many things: enter thou into the joy of thy lord. He also that had received two talents came and said, Lord, thou deliveredst unto me two talents: behold. I have gained two other talents beside them. His lord said unto him, Well done, good and faithful servant; thou hast been faithful over a few things, I will make thee ruler over many things: enter thou into the joy of thy lord. Then he which had received the one talent came and said, Lord, I knew thee that thou art an hard man, reaping where thou hast not sown, and gathering where thou hast not strawed: And I was afraid, and went and hid thy talent in the earth: lo, there thou hast that is thine. His lord answered and said unto him, Thou wicked and slothful servant, thou knewest that I reap where I sowed not, and gather where I have not strawed: Thou oughtest therefore to have put my money to the exchangers, and then at my coming I should have received mine own with usury. Take therefore the talent from him, and give it unto him which hath ten talents. For unto every one that hath shall be given, and he shall have abundance: but from him that hath not shall be

- taken away even that which he hath. And cast ye the unprofitable servant into outer darkness: there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.
- You have been made free from sin. You are now a servant of righteousness, unto the end everlasting life!
- Romans 6:18, 22 Being then made free from sin, ye became the servants of righteousness. But now being made free from sin, and become servants to God, ye have your fruit unto holiness, and the end everlasting life.
- When God pricks your heart with an opportunity to serve him, then serve. Let God develop your talents. You'll be ready when he comes. God gave me 2 Thessalonians 2:7 at Stonelick Lake.
- 2 Thessalonians 2:6-8 And now ye know what withholdeth that he might be revealed in his time. For the mystery of iniquity doth already work: only he who now letteth will let, until he be taken out of the way. And then shall that Wicked be revealed, whom the Lord shall consume with the spirit of his mouth, and shall destroy with the brightness of his coming:
- The wickedness that is holding you back from doing the will of God, will be revealed in his time. You must listen. Only then will he destroy that wickedness with the brightness of his coming. You must have faith. You must act on his instruction. It will not always be convenient for you. Decide to study God's word, to be his witness and find the time and place when and where God communicates with you.
- Keep your life simple, believe in God and go live your life for his glory.
